


A: THE CHEETAH.





## Key Principal #2

Until this point the scripture has discussed the sins of individuals: Adam, Eve, Cain, Lamech. Now for the first time emphasis shifts to the sins of a group, "the sons of God", with the result that Gods punishment is directed not upon a man, but against mankind.



Gen. 6:5-7 The LORD saw how great man's wickedness on the earth had become, and that every inclination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil all the time. 6 The LORD was grieved that he had made man on the earth, and his heart was filled with pain. <sup>7</sup> So the LORD said, "I will wipe mankind, whom I have created, from the face of the earth—men and animals, and creatures that move along the ground, and birds of the air Genesis 6-9 Noch for I am grieved that I have made them."



#### **Text Question:**

If God created all things, did he create evil? Or is evil simply the absence of God?

Gen. 7:5 And Noah did all that the LORD commanded him.




Gen. 9:1 Then God blessed Noah and his sons, saying to them, Be fruitful and increase in number and fill the earth." Genesis 6-9 Noah


