The word **Bless** or **Blessing** has its origins from: Old English *blētsian*, based on *blōd* [*blood*] (i.e., originally perhaps [mark or consecrate with *blood*]). The meaning was influenced by its being used to translate Latin *benedicere* ‘**to praise, worship,**’
