Video Clip - A Job Interview - Wouldn't it be nice if honesty was always so rewarding?

A lack of Honesty is often at the <u>HEART</u> of a broken relationship... and whether its telling or hearing - being <u>HONEST</u> is not <u>ALWAYS</u> easy, and the outcome often creates <u>TENSION</u>... but <u>RECONCILIATION</u> demands honesty!

It was the first problem - Genesis 3:1-14

1. The Tension-

- a. Discovering the truth can take TIME.
- b. Changing our <u>LIVES</u> to <u>REFLECT</u> the truth can be hard work.
- c. Often we're more concerned about others <u>FEELINGS</u> and avoiding <u>CONFLICT</u> in our relationships, than honesty.

2. Making an "honest" living...

- a. Make time to <u>EXAMINE</u> your life and choices. -Lam. 3:40; 1Cor. 11:28: 2Cor. 13:5
- b. Live in ACCOUNTABILITY. -Prov. 27:17; Heb. 10:25
- c. Speak the <u>TRUTH</u> in love. -Eph. 4:15; Col. 3:16; 1Tm. 5:1; 2Tm. 4:2
- d. <u>STUDY</u> the truth. -Psa. 119:9-11; Rom. 12:1-2; 2Tim. 3:16

<u>Psa. 43:3</u> Send forth your light and your truth, let them guide me.

<u>Prov. 12:17</u> A truthful witness gives honest testimony, but a false witness tells lies.

<u>Prov. 23:23</u> Buy the truth and do not sell it; get wisdom, discipline and understanding.

<u>John 14:6</u> Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

Rom. 1:25 They exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator—who is forever praised.

1Cor. 13:6 Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth.

1John 1:6 If we claim to have fellowship with him yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not live by the truth.

1John 1:8 If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us.

<u>James 3:14</u> But if you harbor bitter envy and selfish ambition in your hearts, do not boast about it or deny the truth.
