“Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have because God has said, ‘Never will I leave you nor forsake you.’” Hebrews 13:5



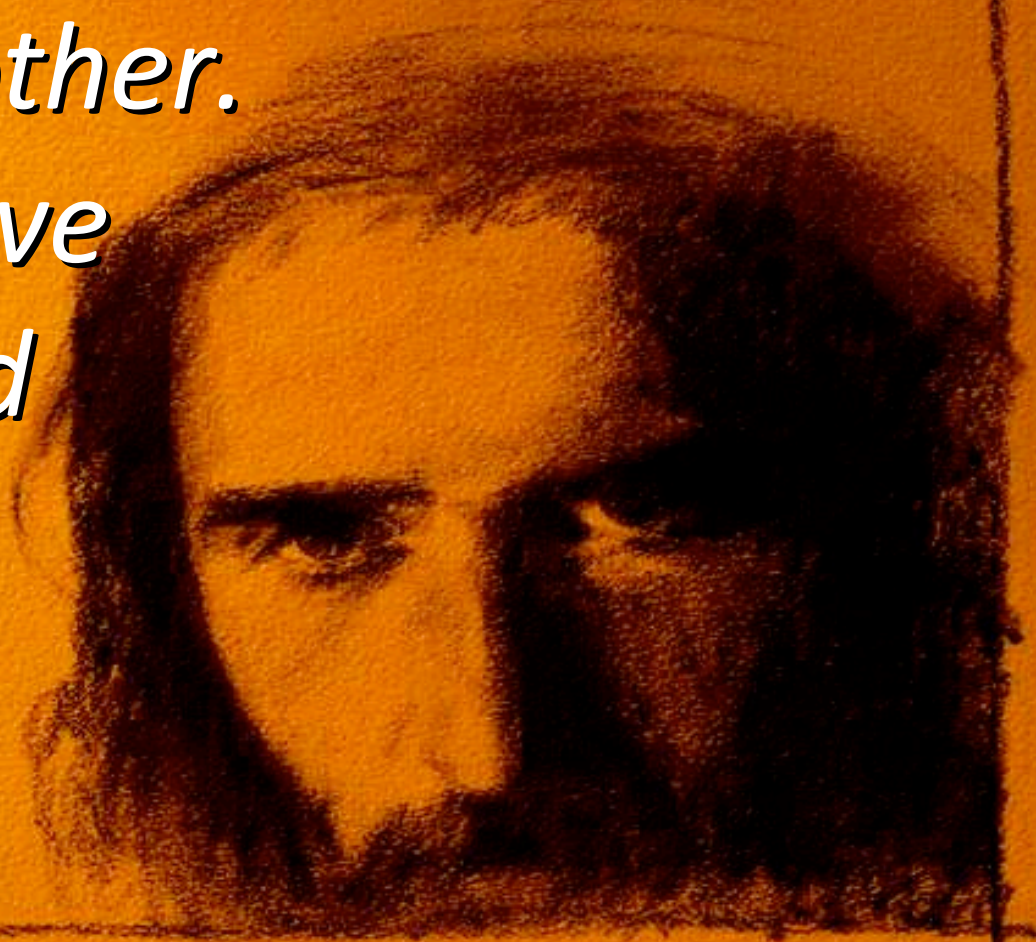

Money can be a by-product of your life but it should never be the goal of your life.



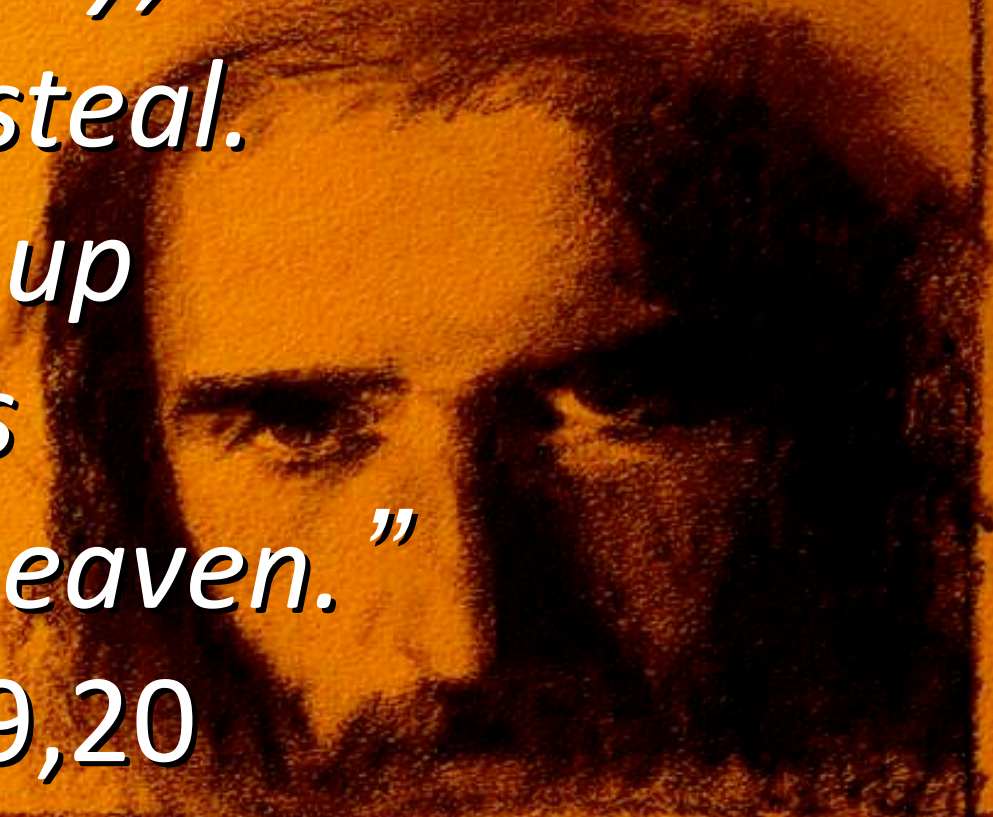
**DON'T
