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
sinful nature = GK. sarx (flesh)





# Temperance Good intentions!

ReReality:

Although Franklin tried to follow the virtues himself, he sometimes strayed from his good intentions.

He wrote: "Be temperate in wine, in eating, girls, and cloth, or the Gout will seize you and plague you both." but, Franklin relished his food, womanized and often dressed to impress people. His food and wine-drinking habits led him to be plagued with the gout for much of his life.

**Romans** 7:1-4

An Illustration From Marriage

<sup>1</sup>Do you not know, brothers—for I am speaking to men who know the law—that the law has authority over a man only as long as he lives? <sup>2</sup>For example, by law a married woman is bound to her husband as long as he is alive, but if her husband dies, she is released from the law of marriage. <sup>3</sup>So then, if she marries another man while her husband is still alive, she is called an adulteress. But if her husband dies, she is released from that law and is not an adulteress, even though she marries another man.

4So, my brothers, you also died to the law through the body of Christ, that you might belong to another, to him who was raised from the dead, in order that we might bear fruit to God.
