Greek word "kata krima" and it simply means Divine judgment.

When the Bible says No condemnation it's saying if you have come to God looking for mercy he freely grants it in His Son Jesus based upon your confession and your belief.

That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. **10**For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved.

But now God has shown us a different way of being right in his sight—not by obeying the law but by the way promised in the Scriptures long ago.²² We are made right in God’s sight when we trust in Jesus Christ to take away our sins.
