


Author of Darwin on Trial, Reason in the Balance "That evolutionary naturalists rely upon cultural stereotypes to shut off all criticisms of their philosophy. The stereotype portrays all opponents (of the evolutionary theory) as extreme Genesis literalists who reject the evidence of science for purely religious reasons. As long as the conflict is perceived this way, the grave scientific defects in the ruling theory (naturalism), and the philosophical bias that sustains it, can be effectively concealed from view."
