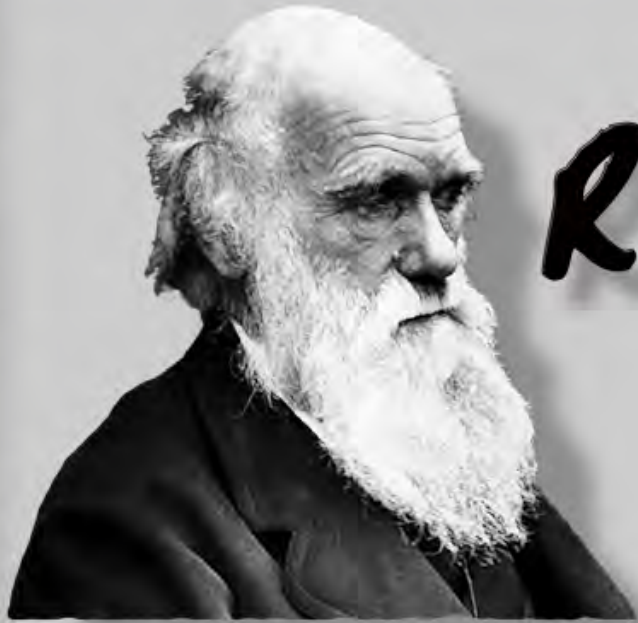

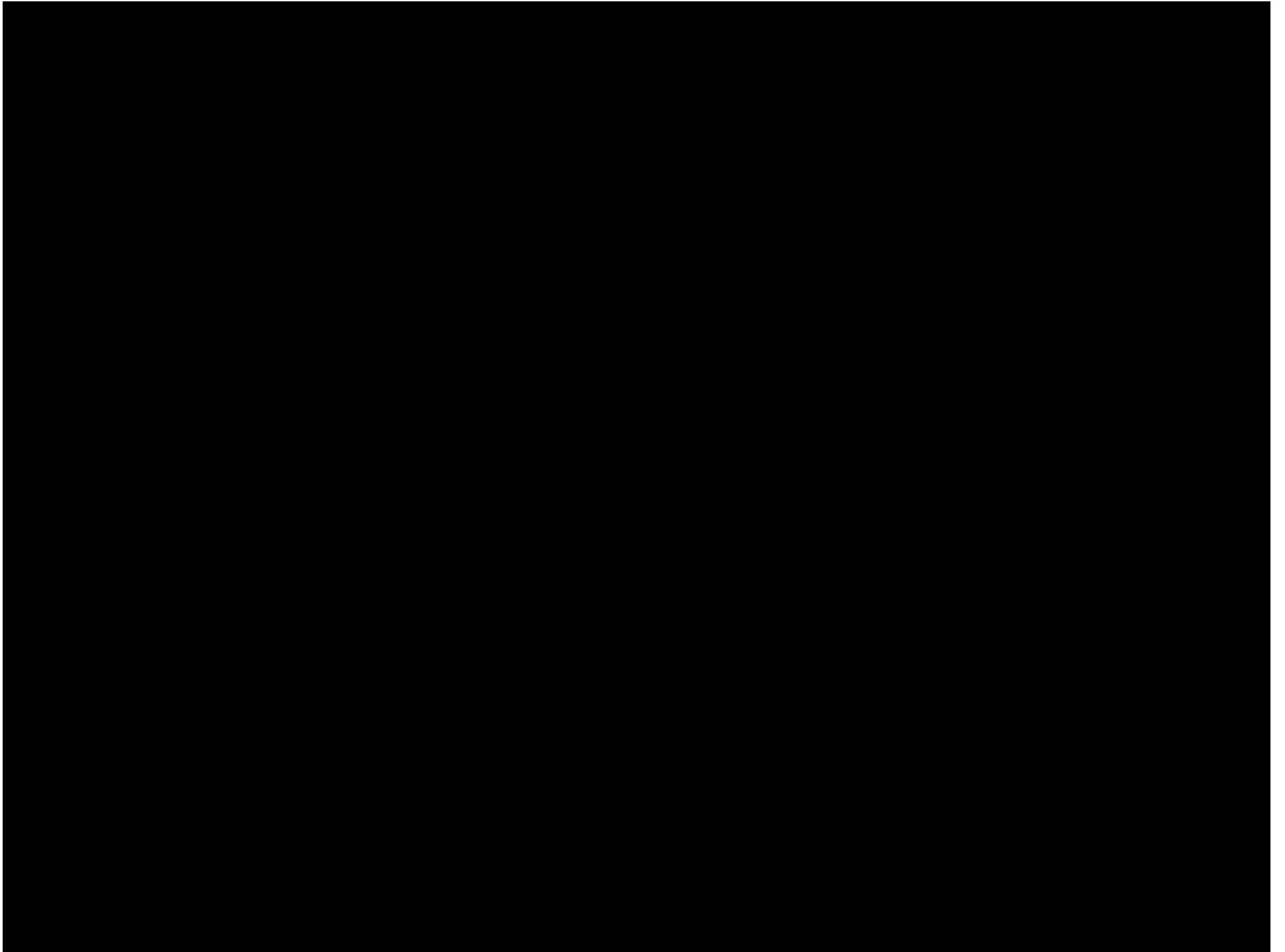

does it just happen to you?***


