
Form a Family

“In his goodness God chose to make us his own children by giving us his true word. And we, out of all creation, became his choice possession.” James 1:18



Jesus, our Lord, was handed over to death because of our failures and was brought back to life so that we could receive God's approval. Romans 4:25





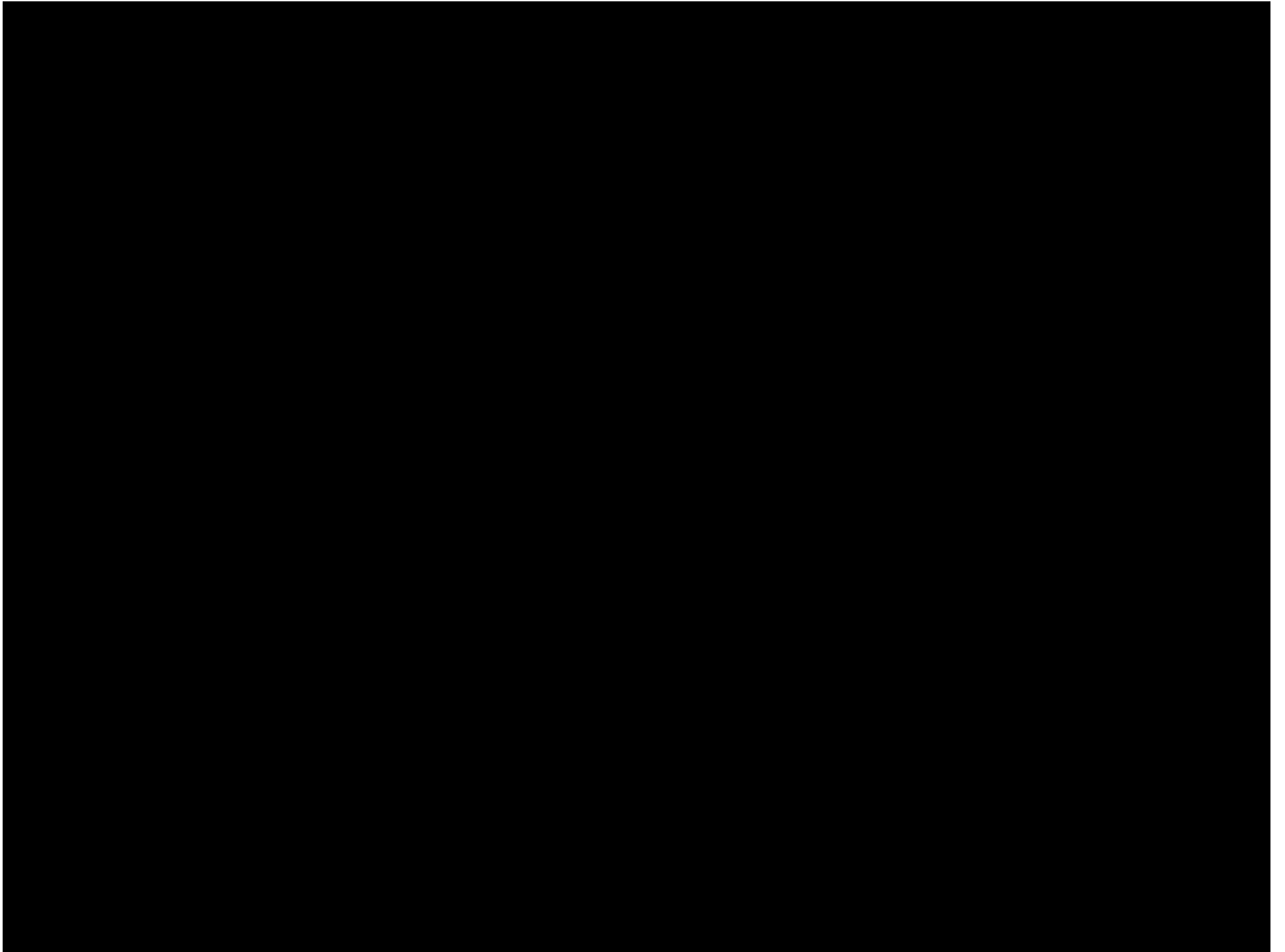
