Learning from David

1Sam. 7:15 Samuel continued as judge over lsrael all the days of his life.



1Sam. 8:7 And the LORD told him: "Listen to all that the people are saying to you; it is not you they have rejected, but they have rejected me as their king.

1Sam. 8:19-20 ¹⁹But the people refused to listen to Samuel. "No!" they said. "We want a king over us. ²⁰ Then we will be like all the other nations.

1Sam. 13:14 14 but now your reign will not endure. The LORD has found a man loyal to Him, and the LORD has appointed him as ruler over His people, because you have not done what the LORD commanded." (HCSB)



1Sam. 15:22 Then Samuel said, "Is the Lord as delighted with burnt offerings and sacrifices as he would be with your *obedience*?" (GWT)



1Sam. 15:24 Saul answered Samuel, "I have sinned. I have transgressed the LORD's command and your words. Because I was afraid of the people, I obeyed them. (HCSB)





1Sam. 16:6 "When they arrived,
Samuel saw Eliab and said,
"Certainly the LORD's anointed one
is here before Him." -(HCSB)



1Sam. 16:7 But the LORD said to Samuel, "Do not consider his appearance or his height, for I have rejected him. The LORD does not look at the things people looks at. People look at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart." -(TNIV)

1Sam. 16:11 Then Samuel asked, "Are these all the sons you have?" "There is still the youngest," Jesse replied. "But he's out in the fields watching the sheep and goats." "Send for him at once," Samuel said. "We will not sit down to eat until he arrives." -(NLT)

1. "but they have rejected me as their king" -1 Sam. 16:8

They wanted independence from God.



2. "Then we will be like all the other nations". - 1 Sam. 16:19-20

They wanted to be like everybody else.



3. "The LORD has found a man loyal to Him" - 1 Sam. 13:14 (HCSB)

God is always at work!

God desires our obedience - not our gifts.

Samuel was enamored with external appearances.




7. Samuel: "Are these all the sons you have?"
