


The story of the *King...* who came to *serve*.




These men dared to do the difficult



These men dared to do the unorthodox











The main problem in all our lives is never our suffering, it's our sin.

"I think when God wants' to play a real rotten practical joke on you, He grants you your deepest wish. And then giggles merrily when you realize you want to kill yourself."


