Now when the Pharisees and some of the scribes who had come from Jerusalem... ²noticed that some of his disciples were eating with defiled hands, that is, without washing them. 3 (For the Pharisees, and all the Jews, do not eat unless they thoroughly wash their hands, thus observing the tradition of the elders)

So the Pharisees and the scribes asked him, "Why do your disciples not live according to the tradition of the elders?"



Jesus' <u>actions</u>, <u>words</u> and <u>feelings</u> brought the Old Testament to life.

He said to them, "Isaiah prophesied rightly about you hypocrites, as it is written, "This people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me; ⁷ in vain do they worship me, teaching human precepts as doctrines.' ⁸ You abandon the commandment of God and hold to human tradition."

(quoting Isaiah 29:13)

It's possible to say the right words and do the right things for all the wrong reasons.

Legalism often...

- 1... produces a feeling of entitlement.
- 2... makes you feel superior to others.
- 3... creates a fear of failure.

You have a fine way of rejecting the commandment of God in order to keep your tradition! 10 For Moses said, "Honor your father and your mother"; and, "Whoever speaks evil of father or mother must surely die." II But you say that if anyone tells father or mother, "Whatever support you might have had from me is Corban."

14 Then he called the crowd again and said to them, "Listen to me, all of you, and understand: 15 there is nothing outside a person that by going in can defile, but the things that come out are what defile." ... 18 "Do you not see that whatever goes into a person from outside cannot defile, 19 since it enters, not the heart but the stomach, and goes out into the sewer?"

²¹ For it is from within, from the human heart, that evil intentions come: fornication, theft, murder, ²² adultery, avarice, wickedness, deceit, licentiousness, envy, slander, pride, folly. ²³ All these evil things come from within, and they defile a person."
