¹⁴ Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit, and news about him spread through the whole countryside. ¹⁵ He was teaching in their synagogues, and everyone praised him. 16 He went to Nazareth, where he had been brought up, and on the Sabbath day he went into the synagogue, as was his custom. He stood up to read,

¹⁷ and the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was handed to him. Unrolling it, he found the place where it is written:

18 The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, 19 to proclaim the year of the Lords favor.

²⁰Then he rolled up the scroll, gave it back to the attendant and sat down. The eyes of everyone in the synagogue were fastened on him. ²¹ He began by saying to them, "Today this scripture is fulfilled in your hearing."

Material Poverty: Nearly half of the world's population live on less \$2 a day & about 1 billion people live on less than a \$1 a day.

Spiritual Poverty: People are unaware of God's love, purpose and provision for them.



* To heal the brokenhearted. Isaiah 61:1

Disappointment: When things (plans, dreams, children) don't turn out the way we hoped.

Rejection: Being turned down by people you love or people you assumed cared about you.

* To bring freedom for the prisoner. Isaiah 61:1

Addictions: Drugs, adrenaline, relationships, pornography and other compulsions that inhibit our ability to experience the fullness of life that God intended.

Secrets: Personal experiences that we feel we can't share.



* To bring freedom for the prisoner. Isaiah 61:1

Fear: Anxieties that we allow to control our lives and rob us of becoming the people God wants us to be.

<u>Unforgiveness:</u> To fully experience God's forgiveness, we HAVE to learn to extend it to others.



* To restore sight to the blind. Isaiah 42:7

Relational: Often we are unaware of our self-defeating behavior.

Spiritual: Closing ourselves off to God's goodness and grace, believing we can get along without Him in our lives.



* To set the oppressed free. Isaiah 58:6


Social/Religious: People all around world who are unable to express their opinions and beliefs.

Slavery: There are an estimated 27 million people enslaved today.



* To proclaim the year of God's favor. Isaiah 61:2

American Heritage Dictionary:



Favor: an act of kindness beyond what is due or usual.

* To proclaim the year of God's favor. Isaiah 61:2

Sabbath: A day of rest every week - begins sunset Friday night and end Saturday night.

Sabbath Year: Every 7th year - rest for the people, land and animals.

Year of Jubilee: Every 50th year - Slaves set free, debts cancelled & land returned to owner.



The Sabbath System reminds us:

To Rest: Life is about more than just what we produce!

Everything is on loan: We don't really own anything.

Trust God to Provide: God knows your needs.
