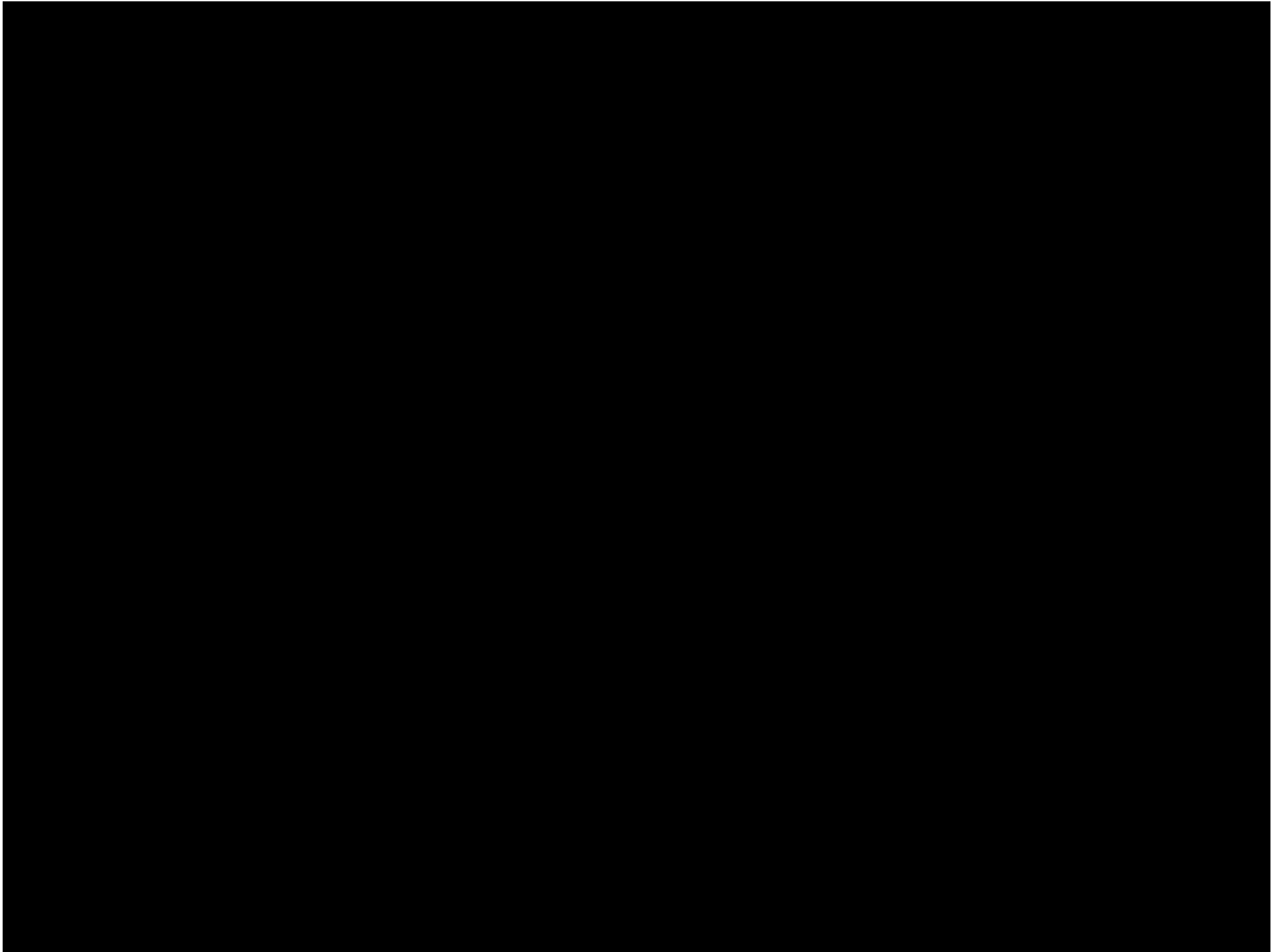

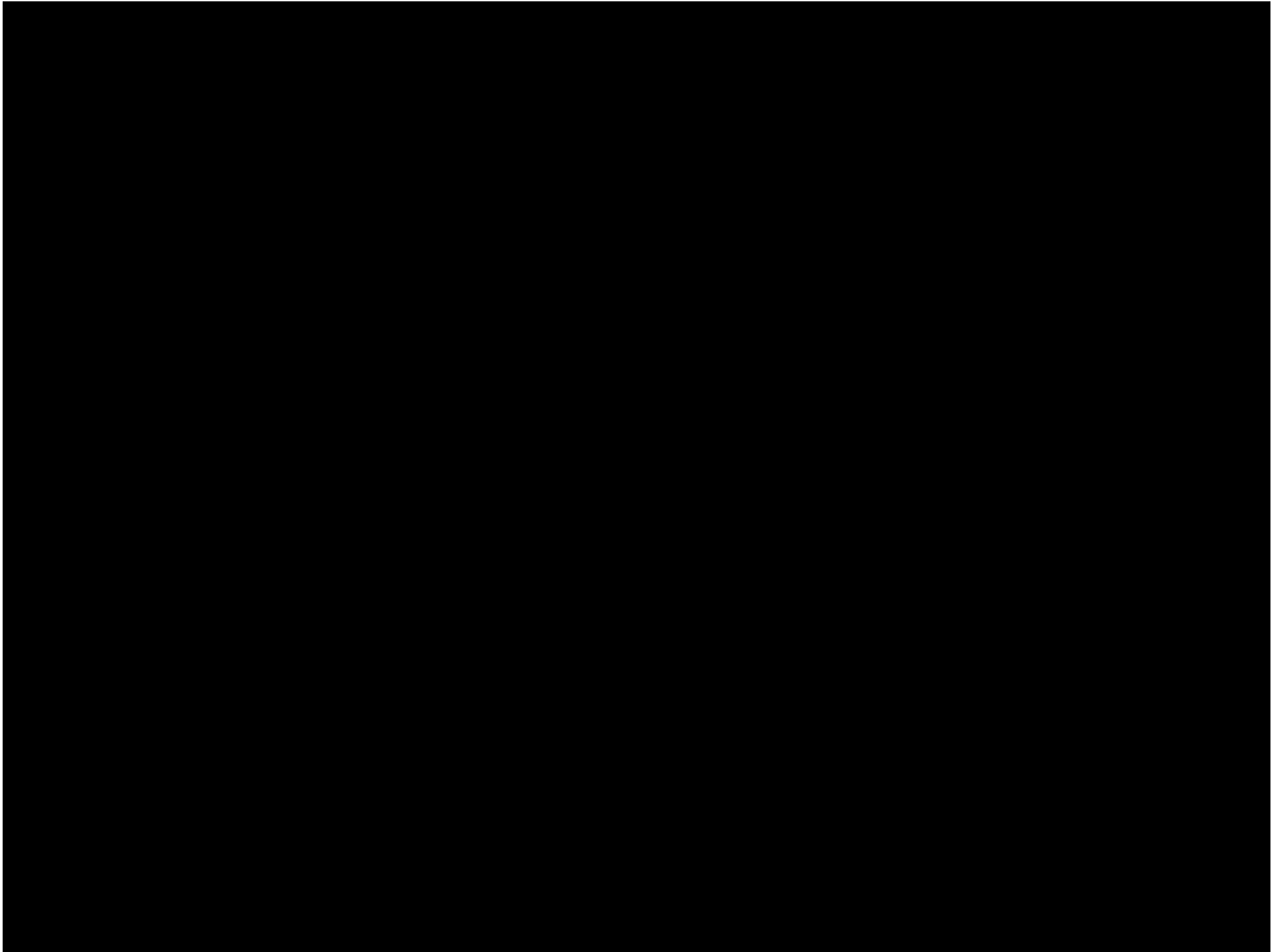


2 Timothy 2:14,15 Paul writes:

Concentrate on doing your best for God, work you won't be ashamed of, laying out the truth plain and simple.

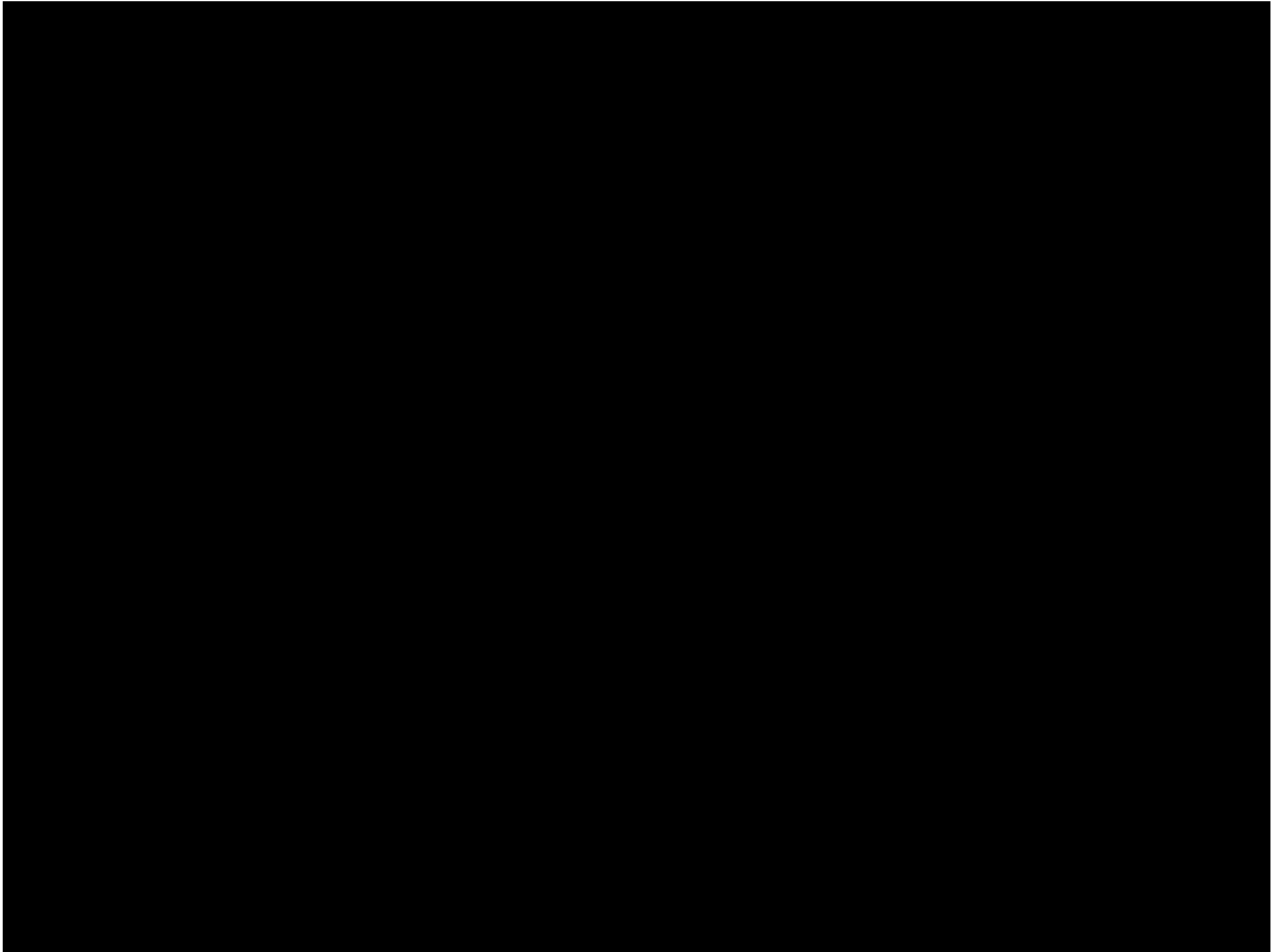
