

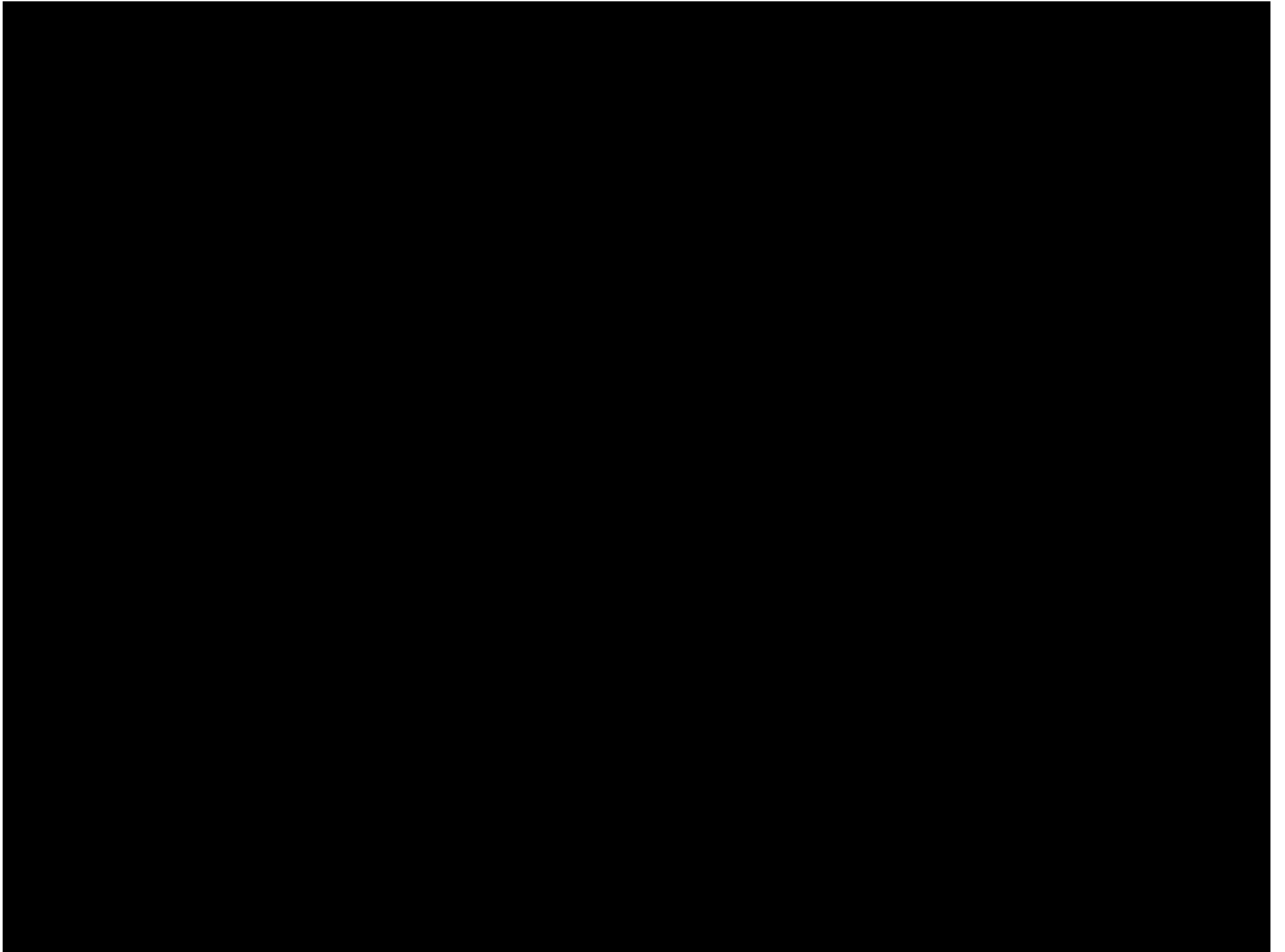

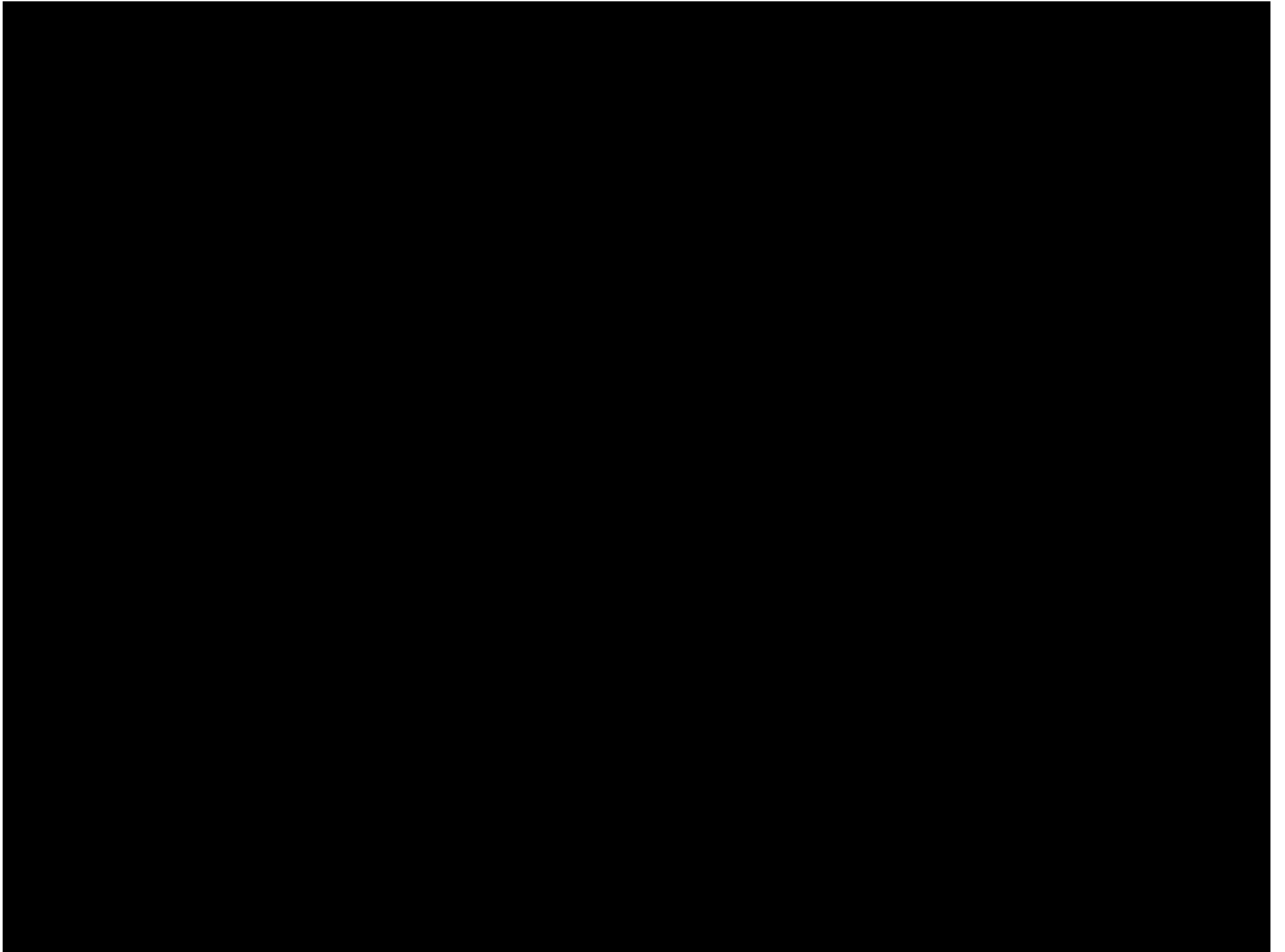


# **1. Fear of EXPOSURE.**

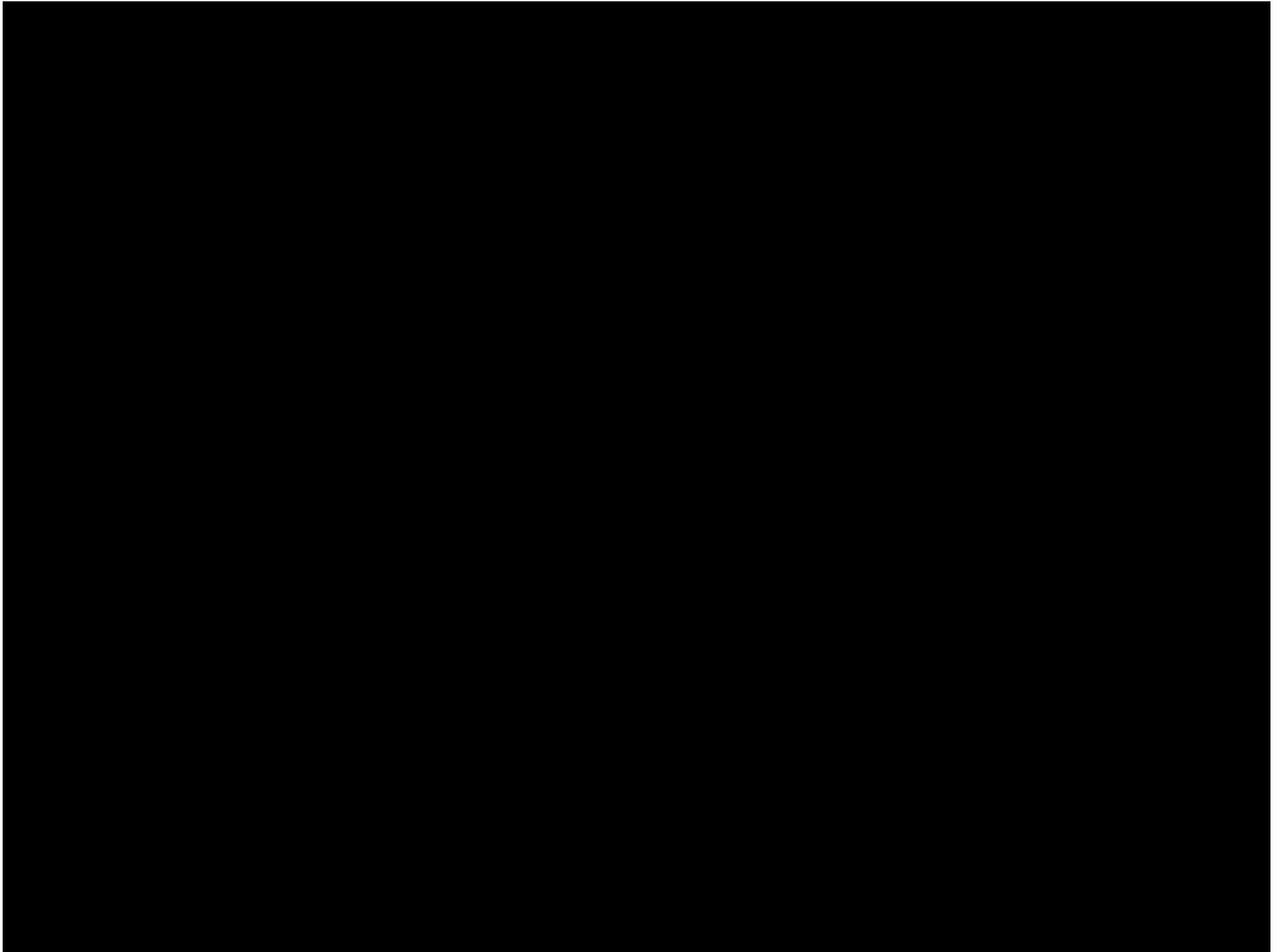

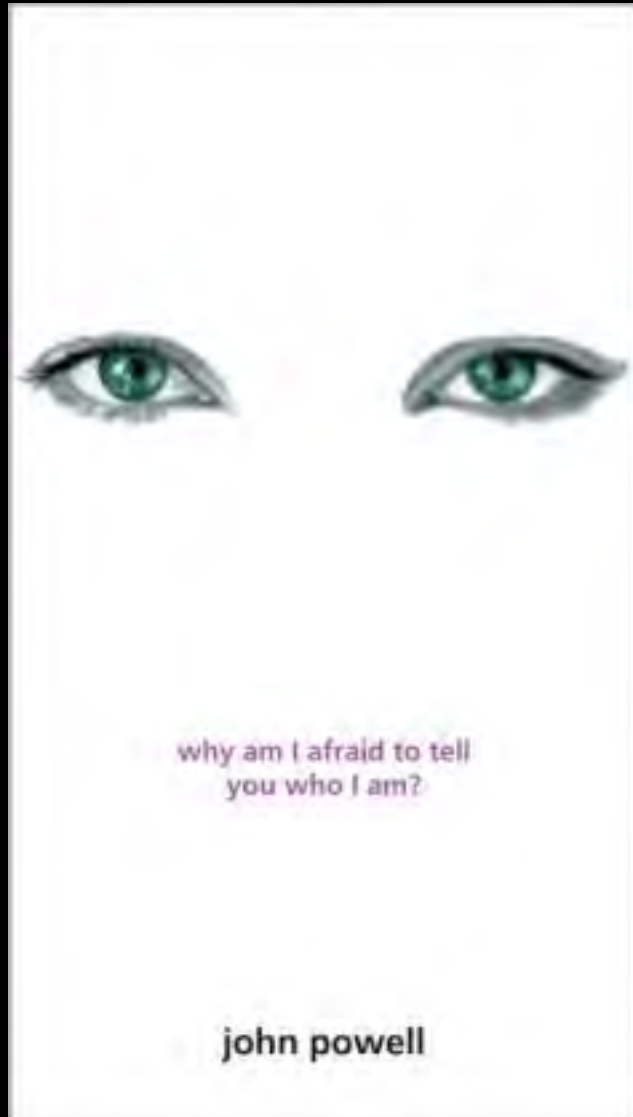

can people do to me?”




**3. Fear of  
BEING HURT AGAIN.**

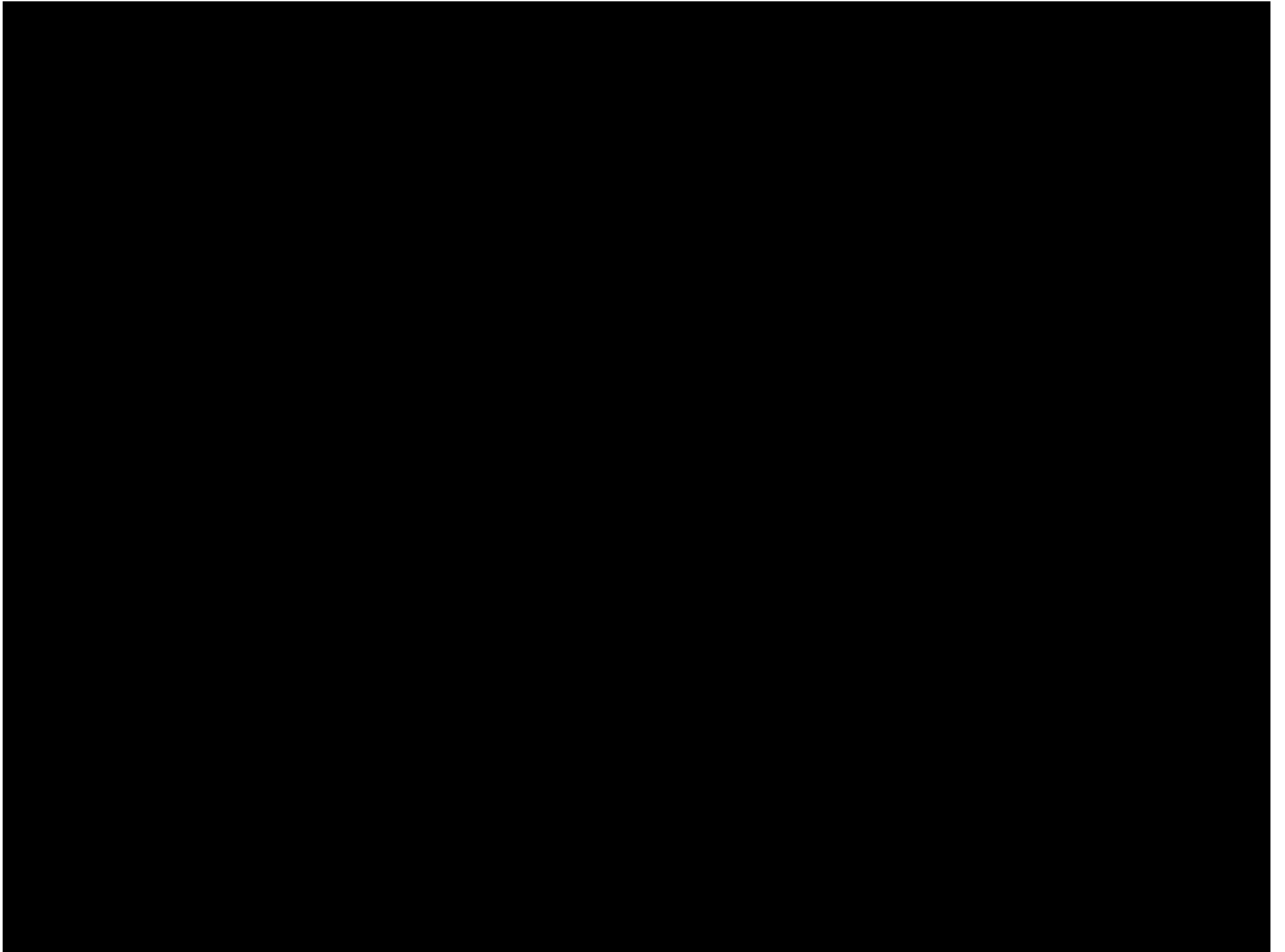






we prophesied in your name and
