





1. He will <u>ease your fears</u>

"Then Jesus said to the paralyzed man 'Be encouraged young man."










2. He will eliminate your guilt

"He has forgiven all your sins. He has utterly wiped out the evidence of broken commandments which always hung over our heads, and has completely annulled it by nailing it to the cross!"





3.He will enable you to do what seems impossible


