**Psalm 25-A psalm of David**

<sup>1</sup>To you, O LORD, I lift up my soul. <sup>2</sup>In you I trust, O my God. Do not let me be put to shame, nor let my enemies triumph over me.

<sup>3</sup>No one whose hope is in you will ever be put to shame, but they will be put to shame who are treacherous without excuse.

<sup>4</sup>Show me your ways, O LORD, teach me your paths.<sup>5</sup> Guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my Savior, and my hope is in you all day long.

<sup>6</sup>Remember, O LORD, your great mercy and love, for they are from of old.<sup>7</sup> Remember not the sins of my youth and my rebellious ways; according to your love remember me, for you are good, O LORD.

<sup>8</sup>Good and upright is the LORD; therefore he instructs sinners in his ways.<sup>9</sup> He guides the humble in what is right and teaches them his way.
