



#### Envy:

1. A feeling of discontented or resentful longing aroused by someone else's possessions, qualities, or luck.



#### The Danger of being ENVIOUS:

- 1. Envy tells us that the grass is greener on the other-side, which robs us of our ability to enjoy what we already have.
- 2. Embracing envy leads us to believe that we know better than God what we ought to have.

I saw them prosper despite their wickedness. 4 They seem to live such a painless life; their bodies are so healthy and strong. <sup>5</sup> They aren't troubled like other people or plagued with problems like everyone else.

#### The "wicked":

verses 6-9; prideful & violent, over indulgent, malicious, arrogant, making threats & they are blasphemous.



12 This is what the wicked are like-always carefree, they increase in wealth. 13 Surely in vain have I kept my heart pure; in vain have I washed my hands in innocence. 14 All day long I have been plagued; I have been punished every morning. Psalm 73

#### 1. He finds truth in the Sanctuary.

#### 2. He confesses his foolishness.

<sup>22</sup> I was senseless and ignorant; I was a brute beast before you.

#### 3. He takes advantage of God's help.

<sup>23</sup> Yet I am always with you; you hold me by my right hand. <sup>26</sup> My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.

### 4. He commits to sharing what he has learned.

<sup>28</sup> But as for me, it is good to be near God. I have made the Sovereign LORD my refuge; I will tell of all your deeds.
