

¹ Blessed are they whose ways are blameless who walk according to the law of the LORD. ²Blessed are they who keep his statutes and seek him with all their heart. ³ They do nothing wrong; they walk in his ways. 174 I long for your

salvation, O LORD, and your law is my delight. 175 Let me live that I may praise you, and may your laws sustain me ¹⁷⁶ I have strayed like a lost sheep. Seek your servant, for I have not forgotten your commands.

How do we grow in Peace, Strength & Confidence in God and His Teaching?

1. Ask God for help. "Teach Me" (10 times)

119:12 Praise be to you, O LORD; teach me your decrees.

119:33 Teach me, O LORD, to follow your decrees; then I will keep them to the end.

119:34 Give me understanding, and I will keep your law and obey it with all my heart.

William Wilberforce won a Bible from his Sunday School teach by repeating Psalm 119 from memory - when he was only nine years old!

2. Share their <u>worth</u>. "Love" (17 times)

119:127 Because I love your commands more than gold, more than pure gold

119:165 Great peace have they who love your law, and nothing can make them stumble.

119:9 How can a young man keep his way pure? By living according to your word.

119:105 Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light for my path.

3. Devote yourself to the "Word". "Obey" (17 times)

119:44 I will always obey your law, for ever and ever.

119:24 Your statutes are my delight they are my counselors.

119:25 I am laid low in the dust; preserve my life according to your word.

119:48 I lift up my hands to your commands, which I love, and I meditate on your decrees.
