(If you, Lord, kept a record of sins) literally means in the Hebrew:	
"The eyes of God are the only eyes that Now, I am not at all concerned about being judged by you or by any human standard; I don't even pass judgment on myself. 4 My conscience is clear, but that does not prove that I am really innocent. The Lord is the one who passes judgment on me. 1 Corinthians 4:3–4	Now, I human conscie

For no one is put right in God's sight by doing what the Law requires; what the Law does is to make us know that we have sinned. Romans 3:20
Vs. 7 Israel, <u>put your hope</u> in the Lord, for with the Lord is unfailing love
Now why would he be telling them to hope in the Lord? Because if you feel unworthy it's because you're looking at something other then God for your hope. Vs. 8 "He himself will redeem Israel" In other words, God himself will come to redeem mankind.
