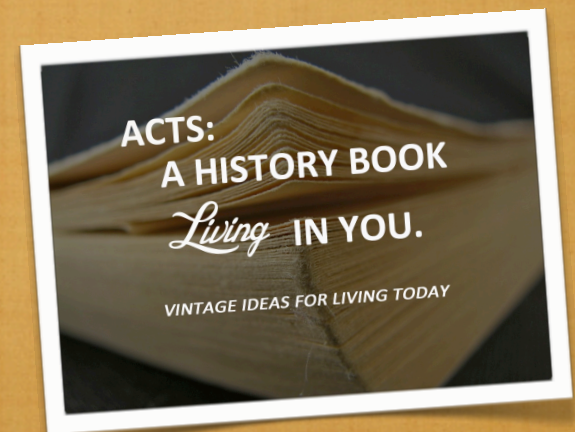


Acts 3:1–13&19

“Peter saw his opportunity”



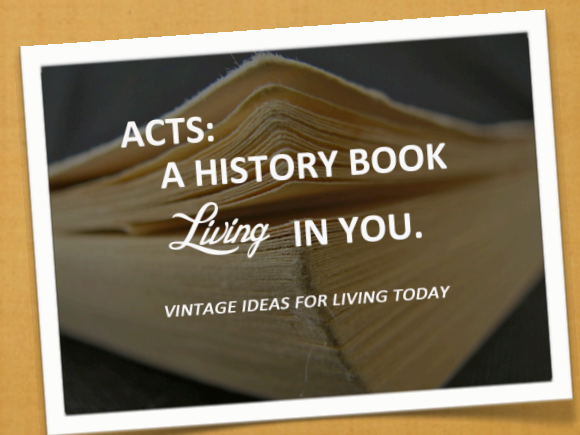

vs.12&13 “by our own power or godliness?... God has brought glory to his servant Jesus by doing this”

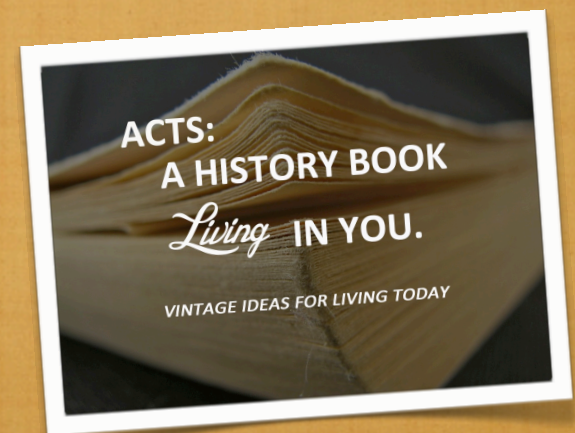


Acts 3:1–13&19
