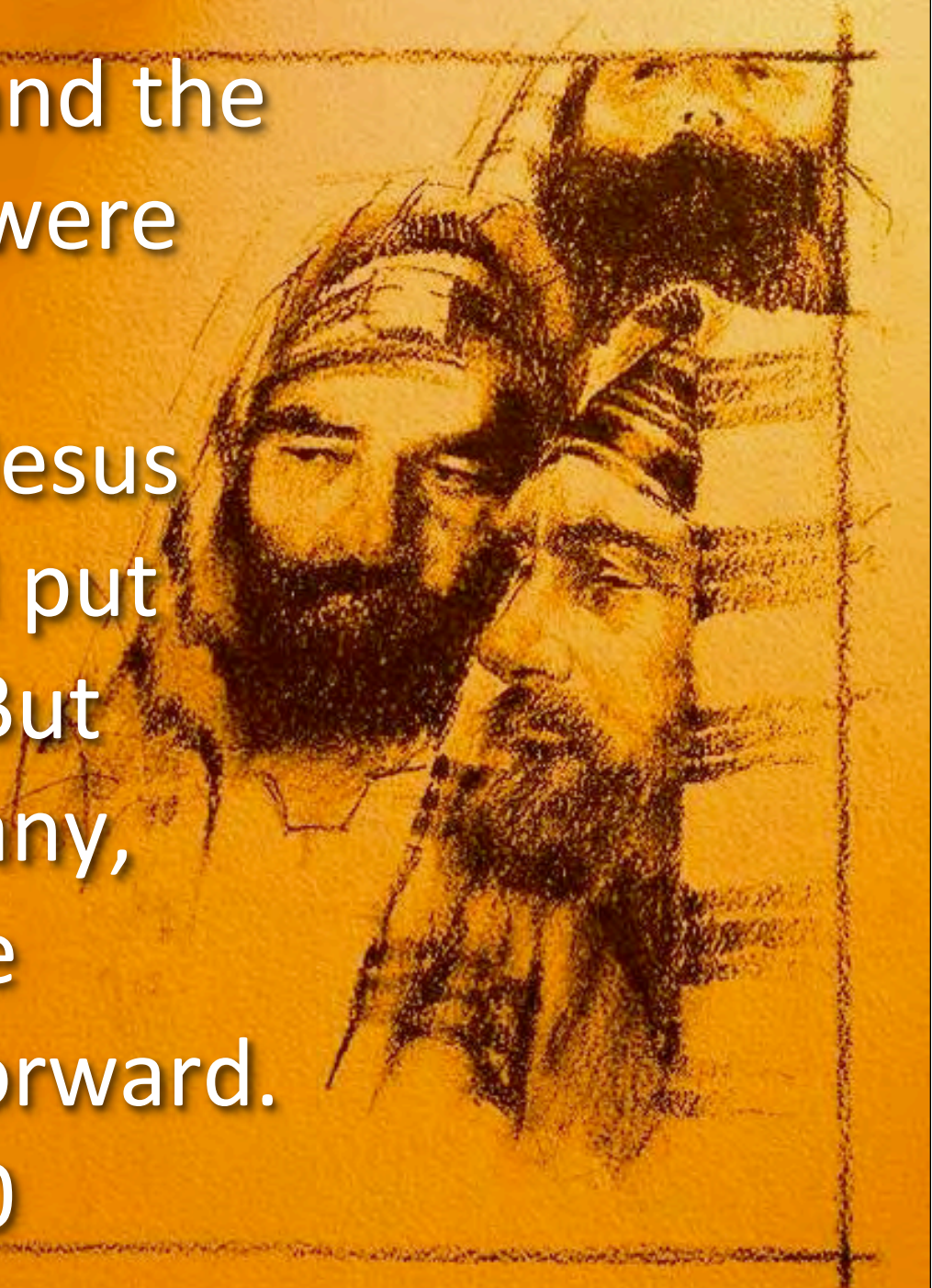




“In Christ we are set free by the blood of his death. And so we have forgiveness of sins because of God’s rich grace.” Ephesians 1:7

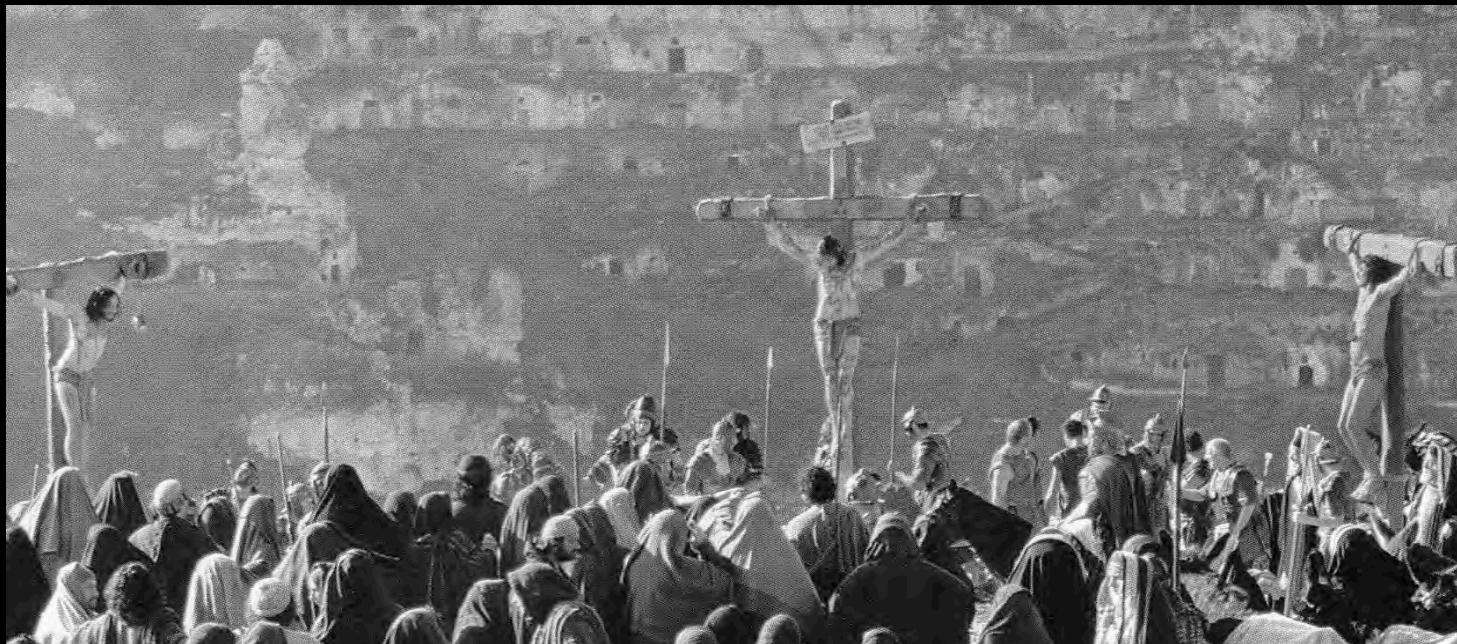

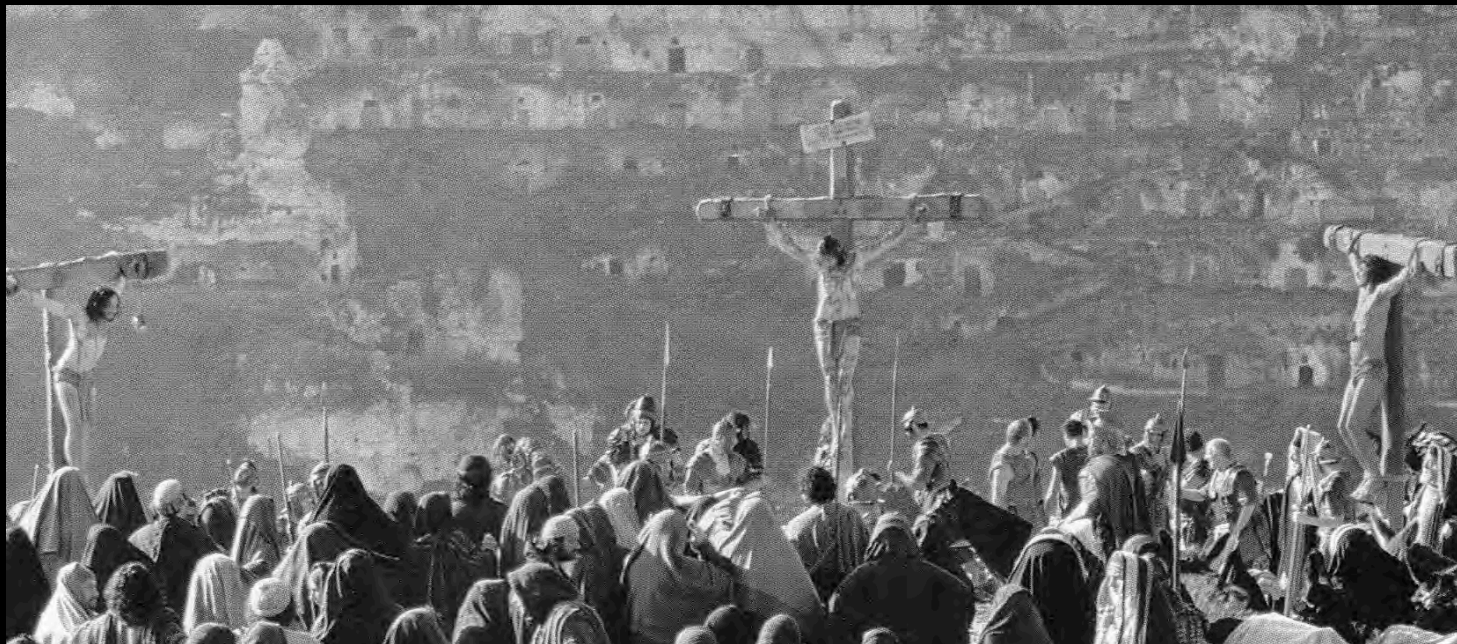

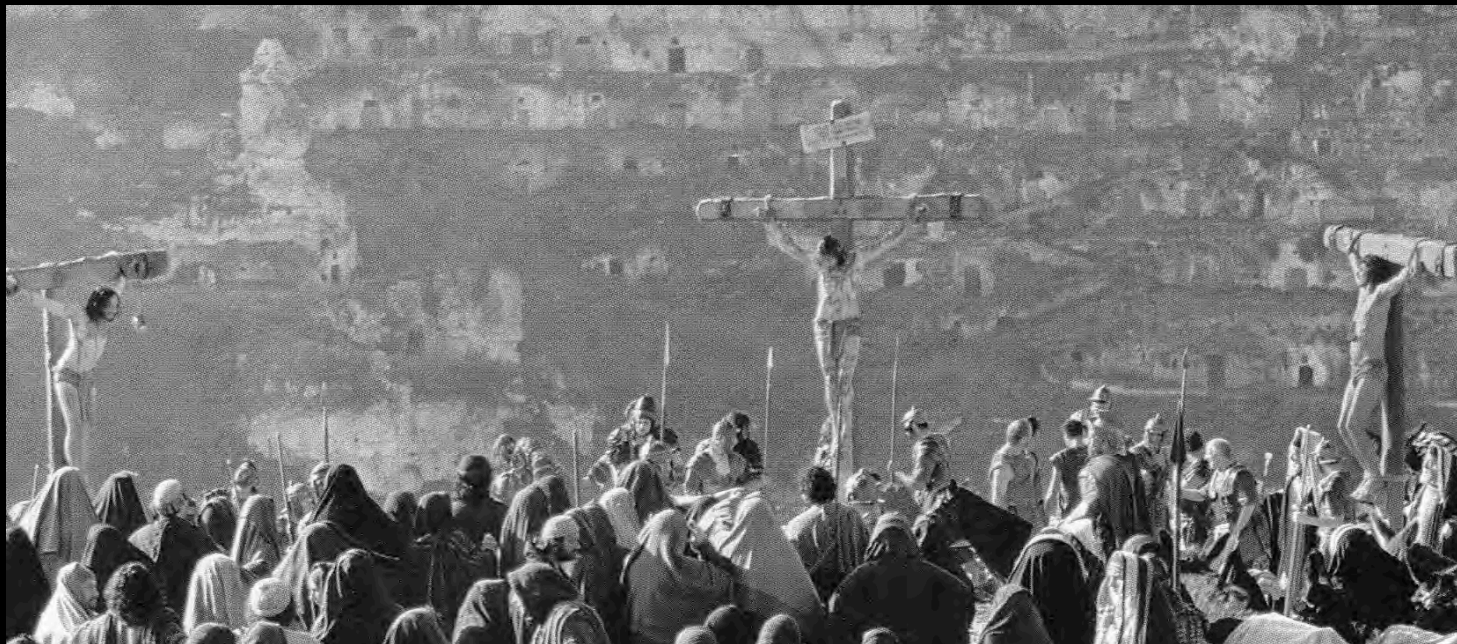
2. I avoid WORDS that make them pay.

What does it mean to forgive?

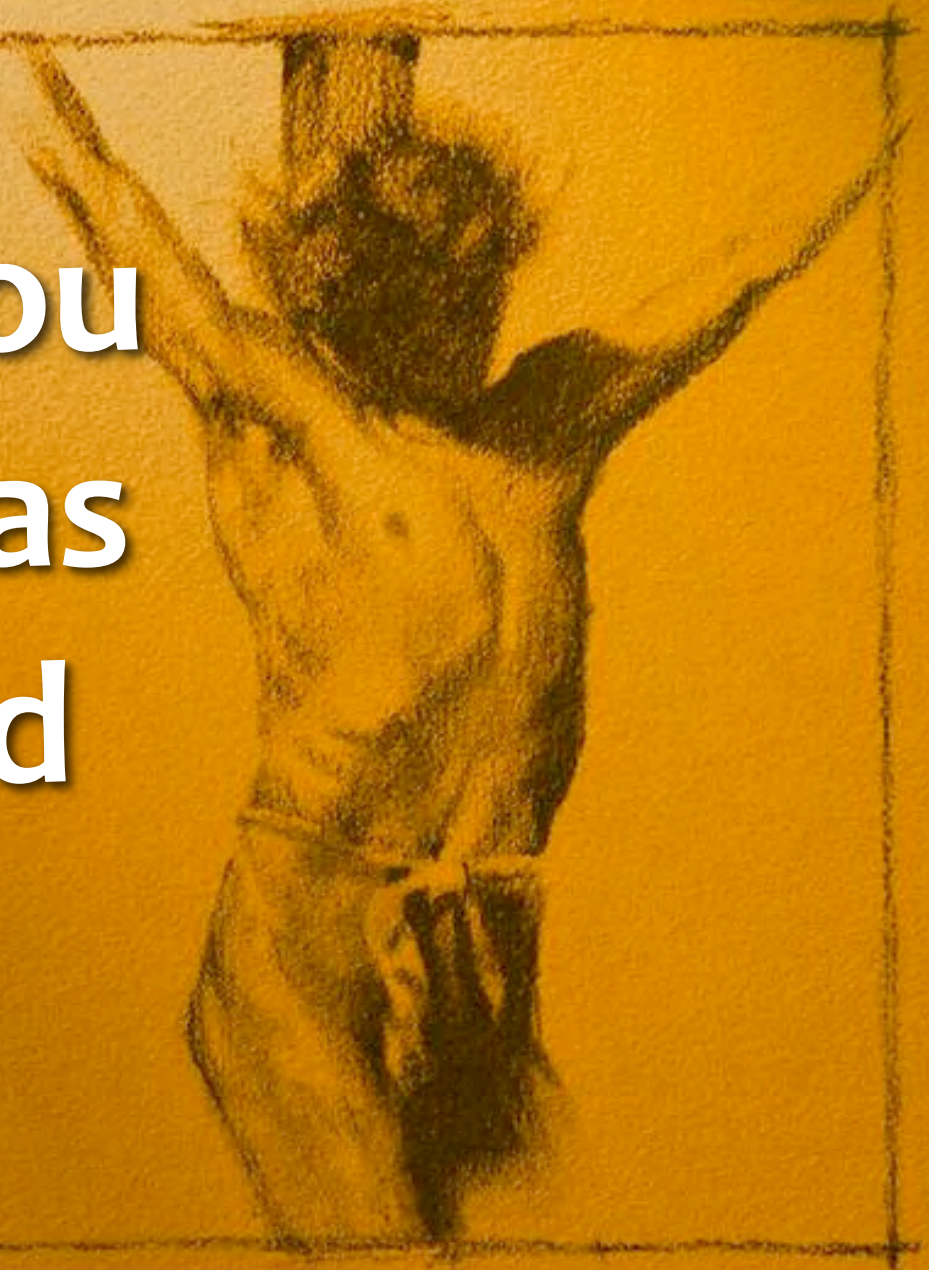

Isaiah 53



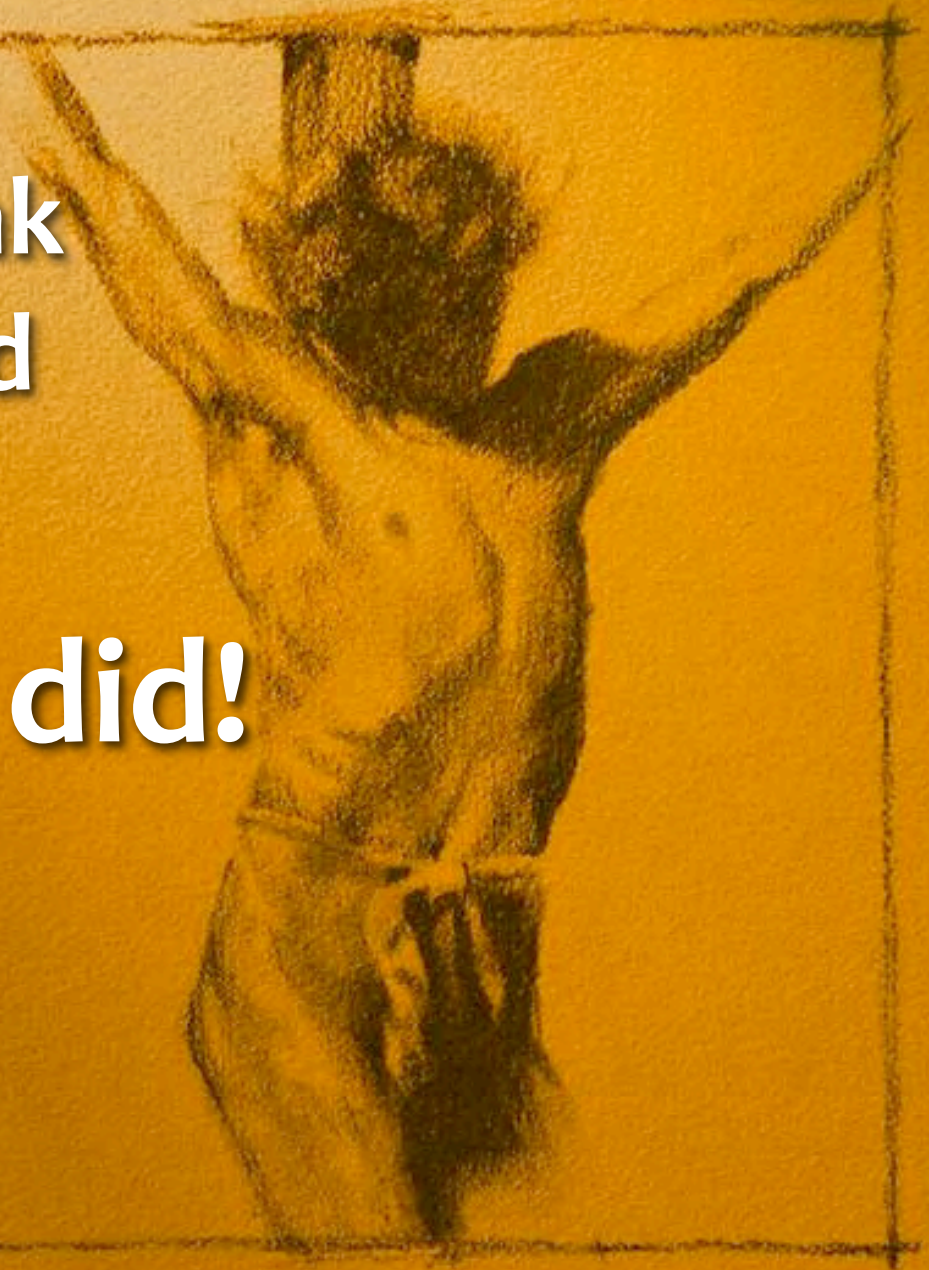

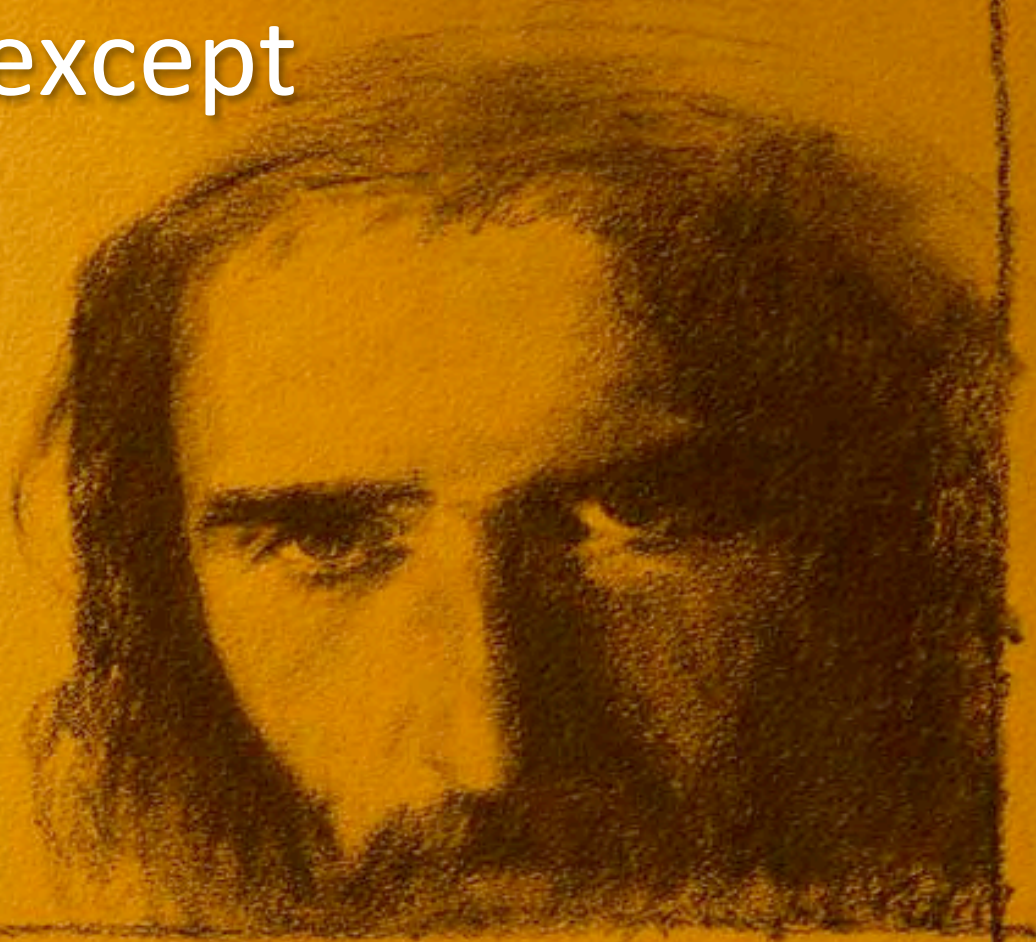


2. You have to see what
