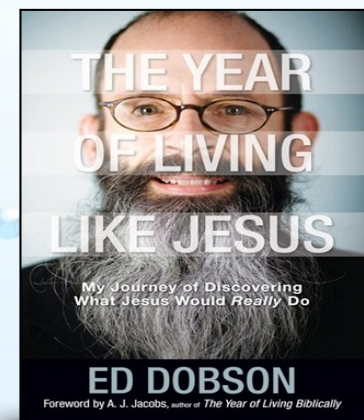
Acts Chapter 28
