It's not about loving kids or career less, it's about loving God more in proportion to them.




#### Trouble, trouble, & MORE trouble...



Acts 20:1-4 When the uproar had ended [in Ephesus], Paul sent for the disciples and, after encouraging them, said goodbye and set out for Macedonia. 2He traveled through that area, speaking many words of encouragement to the people, and finally arrived in Greece, <sup>3</sup> where he stayed three months. Because some Jews had plotted against him just as he was about to sail for Syria, he decided to go back through Macedonia.

Acts 20:7-9 Paul spoke to the people and, because he intended to leave the next day, kept on talking until midnight. 9 Seated in a window was a young man named Eutychus, who was sinking into a deep sleep as Paul talked on and on. When he was sound asleep, he fell to the ground from the third story and was picked up dead.


#### 1. Money is a tool and test.
