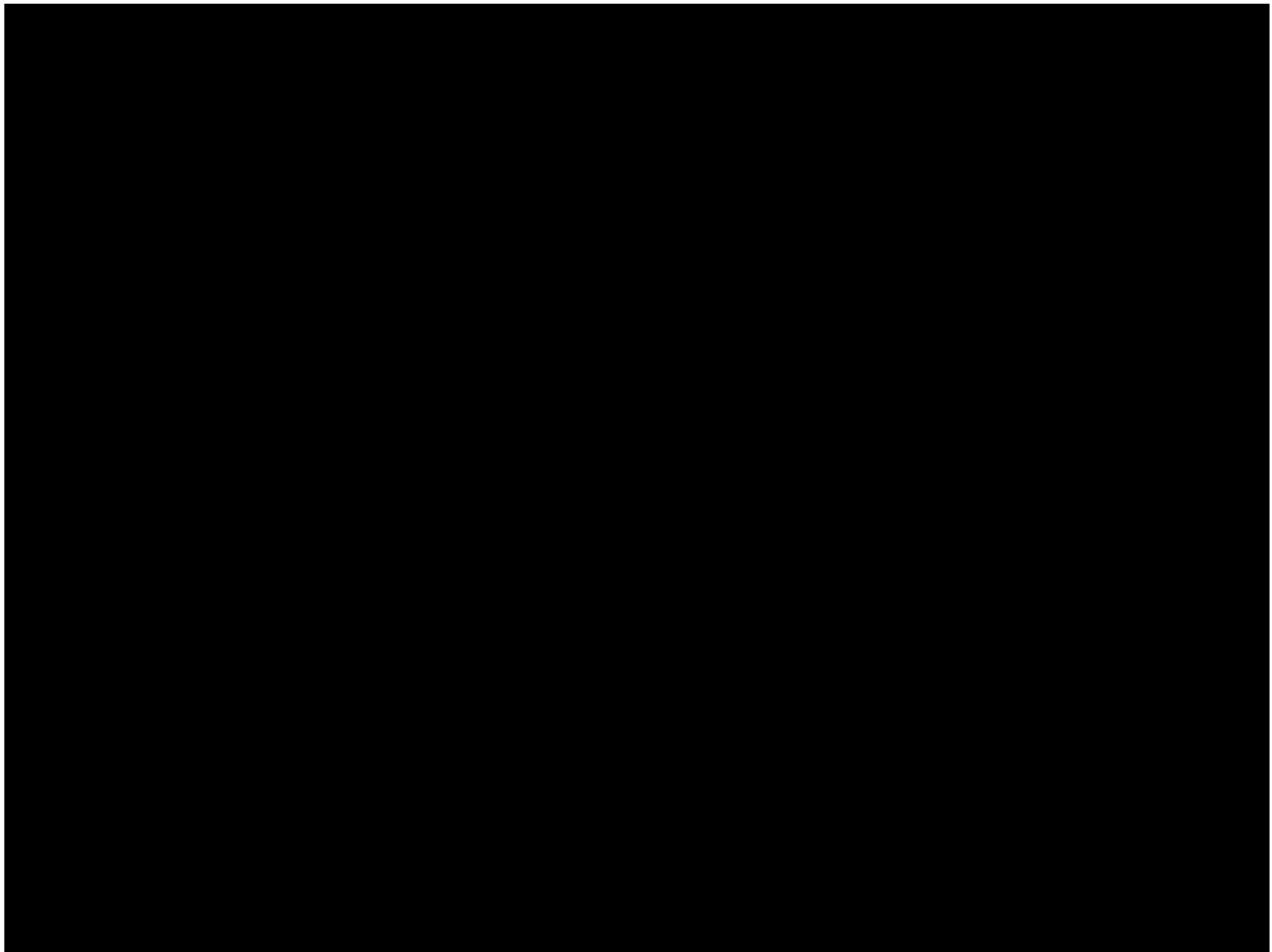
I trust that my life will bring honor to Christ, whether I live or die. **21** For to me, living means living for Christ, and dying is even better.
