<u>Proverbs 6:6-9</u> Go to the ant, you **sluggard**; observe its ways and be wise! ⁷ It has no commander, overseer, or ruler, ⁸ yet it prepares its food in the summer; it gathers at the harvest what it will eat. ⁹ How long, you **sluggard**, will you lie there? When will you rise from your sleep?

<u>Proverbs 26:14</u> As a door turns on its hinges, so a **sluggard** turns on his bed.

<u>Proverbs 19:24</u> The **sluggard** buries his hand in the dish; he will not even bring it back to his mouth!

<u>Proverbs 20:4</u> A **sluggard** does not plow in season; so at harvest time he looks but finds nothing.

Proverbs Contrast the Sluggard with the Diligent

<u>Proverbs 13:4</u> The **sluggard** craves and gets nothing, but the desires of the **diligent** are fully satisfied.
