








Genesis 1:27-28 "He created humanity in His image, created them male and female. 28 Then God blessed them and gave them this directive: "Be fruitful and multiply. Populate the earth. Genesis 1:29-30 Look! I have given you every seed-bearing plant that grows on the earth and every fruit-bearing tree. They will be your food and nourishment. ³⁰ As for all the wild animals, the birds in the sky, and every small creeping creature—everything that breathes the breath of life—I have given them every green plant for food.


