

The tree of life was necessary to sustain all of what it meant to be made in God's image. It's an ongoing relationship to live out what we were made to be.






#### **EXAMPLE ONE:**

Verse 21: "The LORD God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife and clothed them."





"By the blood of Jesus, 20 By his death, Jesus opened a new and life-giving way through the curtain into the Most Holy Place.


