
UNEXPECTED

What Was The Temple For?

1. The place God <u>set</u> <u>aside</u> for the people to gather and worship Him.

2. The place where *sacrifices* were offered for sin.

Why Was Jesus Angry?

1. The "*insiders*" were using the one spot reserved for "*outsiders*" to worship for commerce and convenience, impeding their access to God.

2. A space that was reserved for prayer was being used for the wealthy to get richer.

Why Was Jesus Angry?

3. The Temple was supposed to be a safe haven for those seeking God, but the religious leaders created an environment where corrupt people felt secure. (*Ezek. 35:13*)

How Should We Respond?

1. Everyone Needs a "<u>Palm Sunday</u>" experience. A day where you intentionally invite Jesus in!

2. Examine your life to see if Jesus is "rearranging" your life, inside and out.
