Luke 21:5&6 Some of his disciples were remarking about how the temple was adorned with beautiful stones and with gifts dedicated to God. But Jesus answered them, "Do not think that I will come here to destroy the temple. It is not the temple that I am talking about. I am talking about the body of the Son of Man. For what you see here, the Son of Man will destroy. He will not leave one stone on another, because the days will come when not one stone will be left on another; one of them will be thrown down."

Matt.4:5-7 Then the devil took him to the holy city and had him stand on the highest point of the temple.
6 "If you are the Son of God," he said, "throw yourself down. For it is written: "He will command his angels concerning you, and they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone."
7 Jesus answered him, "It is also written: 'Do not put the Lord your God to the test.'



What Was The Temple For?

1. The place God set aside for the people to gather and worship Him.

Why Was Jesus Angry?

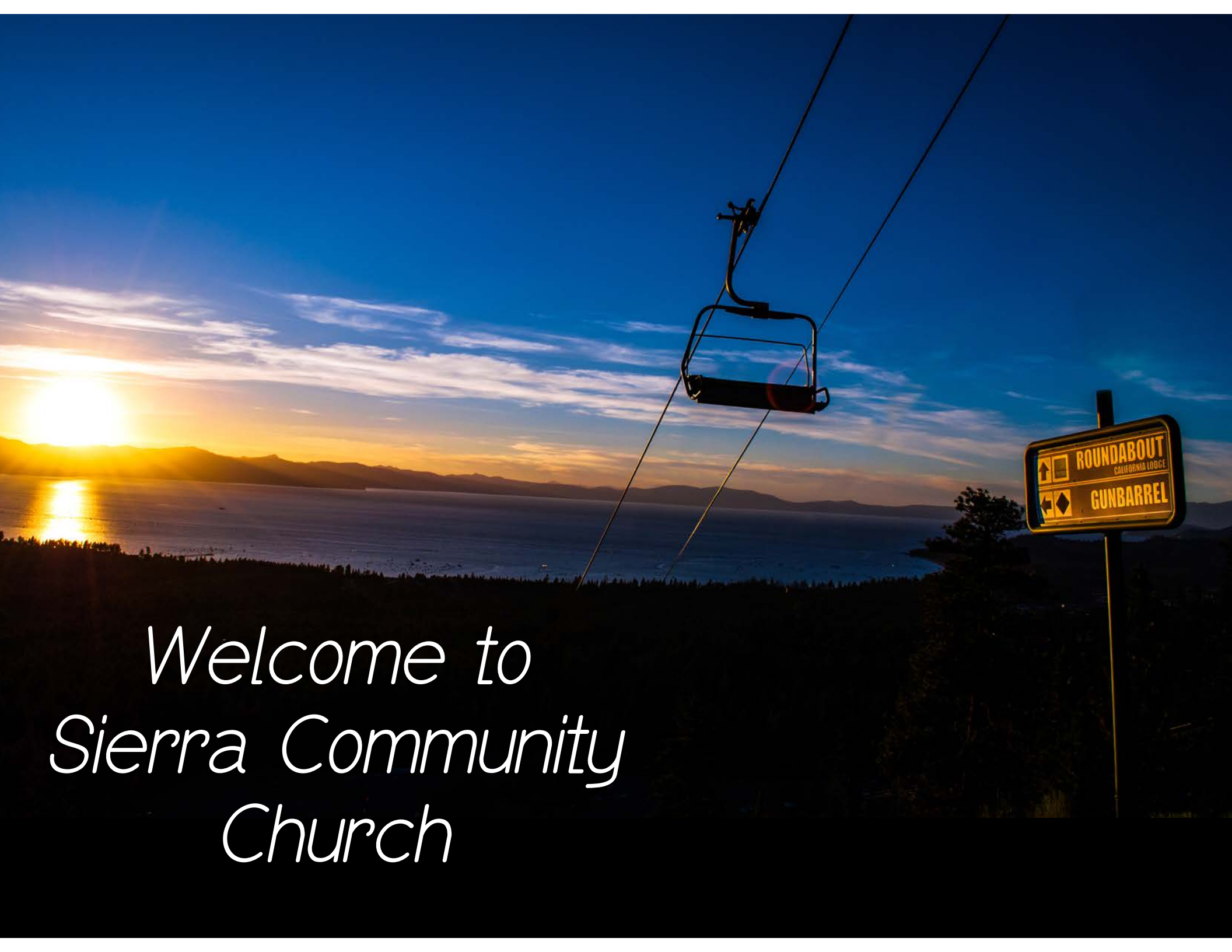
1. The “insiders” were using the one spot reserved for “outsiders” to worship for commerce and convenience, impeding their access to God.
2. A space that was reserved for prayer was being used for the wealthy to get richer.

Why Was Jesus Angry?

3. The Temple was supposed to be a safe haven for those seeking God, but the religious leaders created an environment where corrupt people felt secure. (*Ezek. 35:13*)

How Should We Respond?

1. Everyone Needs a “Palm Sunday” experience. A day where you intentionally invite Jesus in!
2. Examine your life to see if Jesus is “rearranging” your life, inside and out.
