


**Isaiah 53:3-11** (7 Century B.C.)

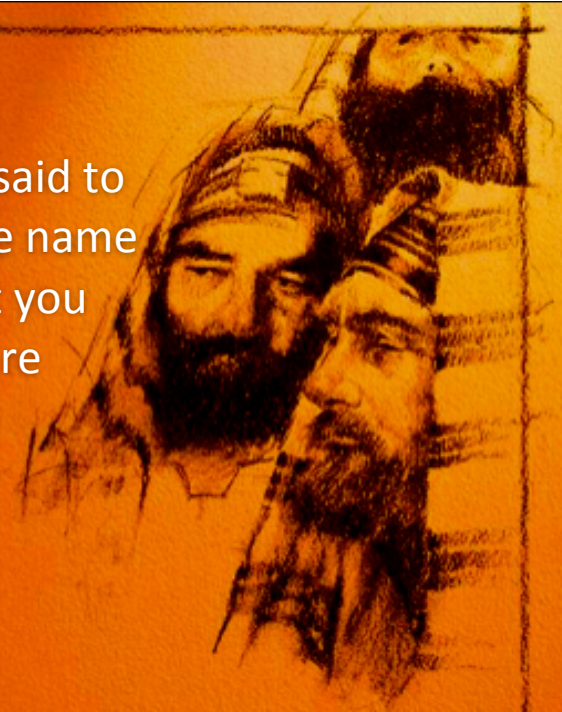

But it was the Lord's good plan to crush him and fill him with grief. Yet when his life is made an offering for sin, he will have a multitude of children, many heirs.

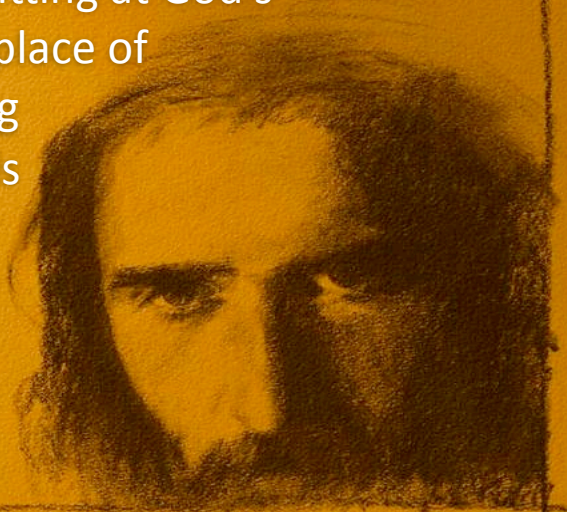


Matthew Chapter 26

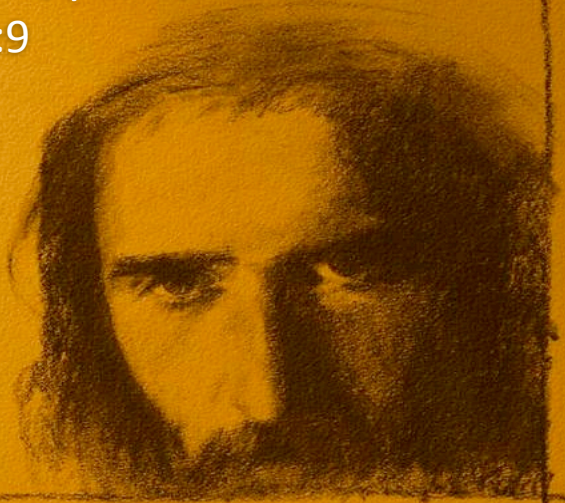

Jesus (*to Philip*): 9 I have lived with you all this time, and you still don't know who I am? If you have seen Me, you have seen the Father. John 14:9




Philippians 2:6-11 says,

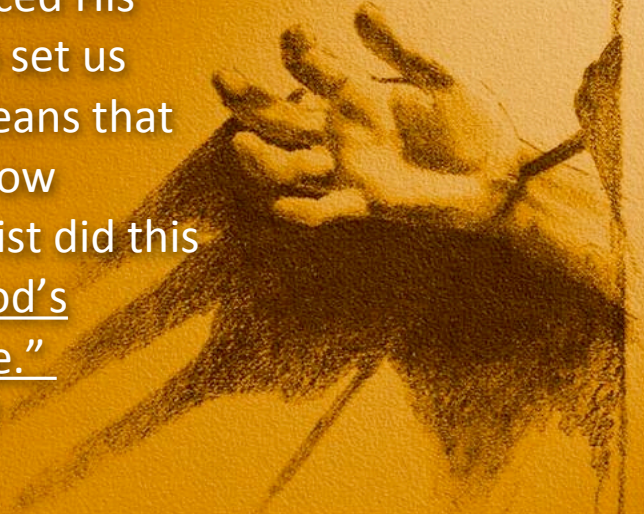



## Paul writes: 1 Corinthians 15:4-8

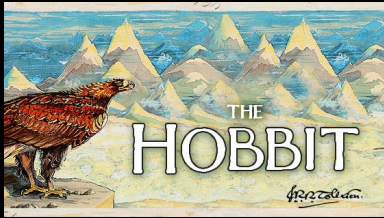
