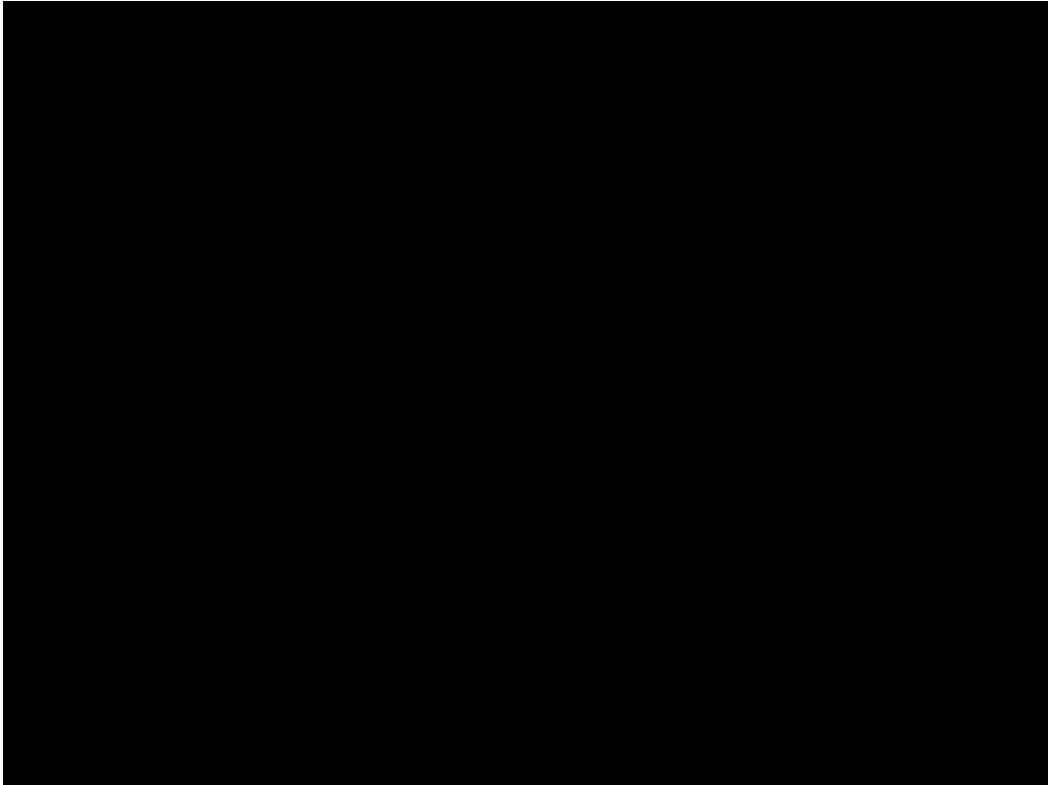

Genesis Chapter 22 Verse 2

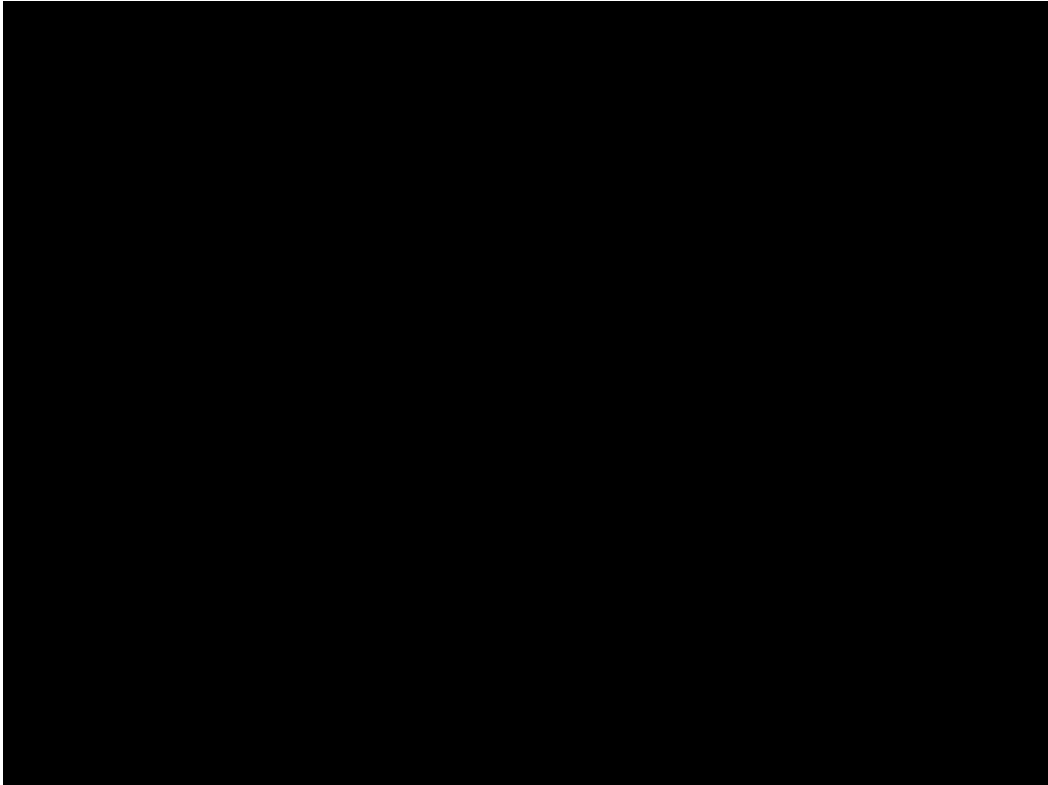

life without God.



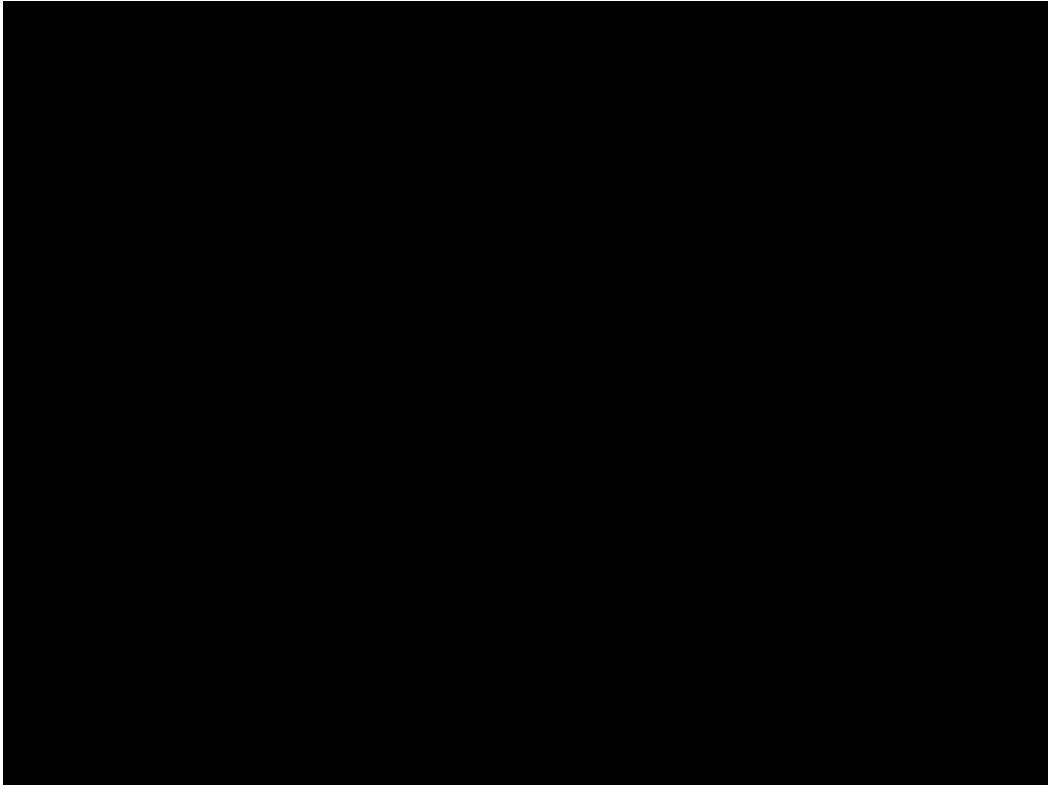
Genesis Chapter 22 Verse 2
