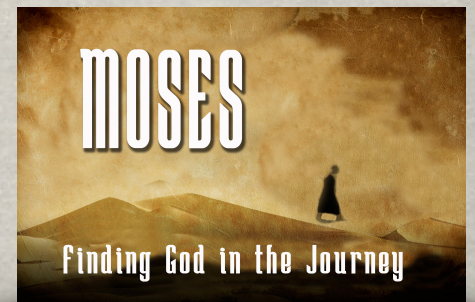

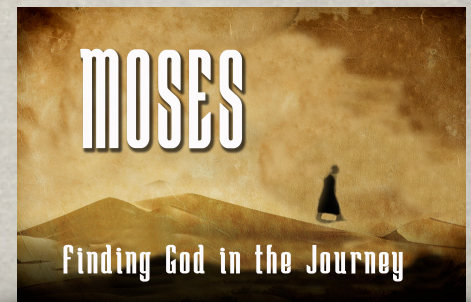

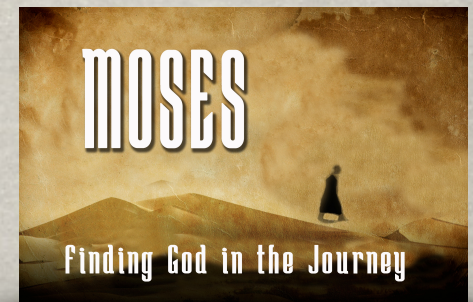
Exodus 16:2

“they clamored against him, and had stones in their hands in order to dispatch him.” -Antiquities of the Jews — Book III Ch.1:4

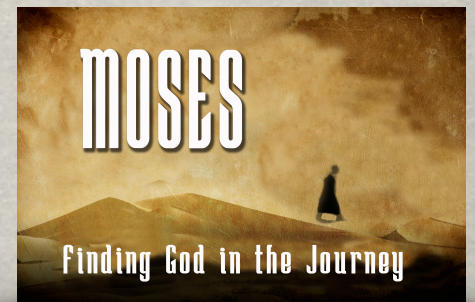
