

Dear Sierra Family,

In last weekend's message, "The Red Sea Crossing Pastor Dan looked at "How God does Salvation". As you go through your week, use the Message Action Plan below to help put the things you've learned into practice.

Seven truths for seven days of the week. Focus on acting on one of these truths each day this week.

#1: Remind yourself that whatever you live for in this life you will serve it.

Exodus16:3, "In Egypt we sat around mountains of meat, and we ate all the food we wanted. Yet you have brought us into the desert to starve."

The Israelites amidst some discomfort as they crossed the Sinai Desert, seemed to forget that they were slaves in while in Egypt under a heavy yoke of persecution. They seemed willing live in and for Egypt again, but had they gone back, they would have been brutally enslaved as they had been previously. Chalk this up as falling victim to the "Grass is always greener in the other pasture" mentality.

#2 When we come to God through Jesus, it's not so we can live anyway we want, rather we're called into relationship with God on his terms.

"Let my people go, so that they may worship me." Exodus 8:1 God helps us escape from serving anything but him.

3: Whatever you are serving will control your life and enslave you whether it's a bad thing or a good thing.

When you have something that's good in your life, how do you keep from being consumed by the fear of what you'd lose if something went wrong with it? That's why Jesus Christ says,

"For my yoke is easy and my burden is light." Matthew 11:30 Because every other yoke will crush you.

4: The second thing we learn about how God does salvation is that salvation in the Bible works completely differently, than it does in any other religion. John 5:24, "I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to

Unexpected Timing


-Abraham: God promises to make him a great nation and to bless the whole world through Abraham! (Genesis 12)

A shoot will come up from the **<u>stump</u>** of Jesse; from his roots a Branch will bear fruit. -Isaiah 11:1

He compared the royal dynasty of David to a tree stump.
