


Studies from the life of Job.

### When you suffer, it's so natural to ask the question, why?




"Have you seen my servant Job? There is none like him in all the earth; a man who fears God and shuns evil."

Verse 8



"Does Job fear God for nothing?" Satan replied. 10 "Have you not put a hedge around him and his household and everything he has? You have blessed the work of his hands, so that his flocks and herds are spread throughout the land.

## "Who is this that obscures my plans with words without knowledge? Job 38:2




What the Bible calls us to do is to serve God even though you will never know, just like Job never knew, the actual reasons for the suffering.



We also <u>celebrate in seasons of suffering</u> because we know that when we suffer we develop endurance, 4 which shapes our characters. Romans 5: 3,4




Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, ... James 1:2

## But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners. Romans 5:8




For since our friendship with God was restored by the death of his Son while we were still his enemies, we will certainly be saved through the life of his Son.
