## **Chapters 38-42 - God's Response:**

### 1. A Frame of Reference.

To Job: *What* understanding do you have of the founding of the cosmos?

**How** is the cosmos sustained and ordered?

<u>Who</u> designed the intricacies of the animal, plant, and weather system?

Would you suppose you can correct my work?

<u>The Main Point:</u> Job's understanding of the complexities of the world and its order are limited. The world as God has made it is amazing, but it is not designed to prevent suffering.

### 2. The Silence of God.

Most readers find it very disappointing that God never answers or gives Job any insight as to why he has had to endure so much suffering.

<u>The Main Point:</u> God is not offering an answer but an invitation to choose to trust in the absence of knowing.

## Chapters 40&42 - Job's Response:

<u>Job's 1<sup>st</sup> response:</u> Saying "nothing more" is essentially adopting a stance of neutrality, not affirming the truth.

<u>Job's 2<sup>nd</sup> response:</u> Job gives a full confession and rather than asking for vindication, he gives it to God!
