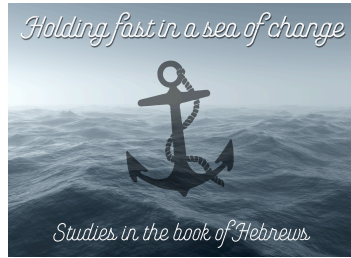


Inviting God to INCREASE His influence in your life.

Purpose:

1. The fullness of God and security of salvation are found fully in the person and work of Jesus. -Heb. 1:4-14; 3:3; 4:14-16; 10:11-12; 8:6
2. The book is written to encourage people in challenging circumstances. -Hebrews 12:1-2
3. The book is written to remind people of the consequences of not taking Jesus seriously! -Hebrews 2:3

Preparation:

“In the past God spoke to our ancestors through the prophets at many times and in various ways but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son.” Hebrews 1:1-2

Presentation:

“whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom also he made the universe ³ The Son is the radiance of God’s glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After he had provided purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven” -Hebrews 1:2

Preeminence:

He is the final word till end of the age.

He's the heir of all things.

He made the world.

He's the radiance of God's glory.

He's the exact representation of God.

He upholds all things by the power of His word.

He is the One who made purification for sins and sat down at the right hand of the majesty on high.

Precaution:

We must pay the most careful attention, therefore, to what we have heard, so that we do not drift away. ² For since the message spoken through angels was binding, and every violation and disobedience received its just punishment, ³ how shall we escape if we ignore so great a salvation? -Hebrews 2:1-3

Proposal:

If Jesus has done what the Bible says He’s done and Jesus is who the Bible says He is, what is the proper way to respond?
