The whole world suffers from this sin of self-glorifying.

Lewis Smedes:

"Pride in the religious sense is an arrogant refusal to let God be God. It is to grab God's status for one's self. We force other people to act as buttresses for the shaky ego that pride created. 'How can this person contribute to my need for applause and power?' Vanity creates the need to use people because we cannot keep our balance spiritually if we are empty at the center."

Unless you are profoundly sure of your value/significance in Christ then to some degree you will use others for personal gain.

For in Christ lives all the fullness of God in a human body. ¹⁰ So you also are complete through your union with Christ. Colossians 2:9,10

By his divine power, God has given us everything we need for living a godly life. 2 Peter 1:3

Creating Idols:

Sexual Sin- "What sorrow awaits you who make your neighbors drunk! You force your cup on them * so you can gloat over their shameful nakedness. Hab.2:15 *Which is a euphemism for having sex with them.

Environmental Sin- You cut down the forests of Lebanon. Now you will be cut down. You destroyed the wild animals, so now their terror will be yours .Hab. 2:17

Liberal agenda says, *"Harming the environment is a sin!"* Conservative agenda says, *"Sleeping around is wrong."* Only the Bible says it's all a sin.

So whether it's liberal or conservative, capitalist or socialist, religion or secular, our **idols** will drive our attitudes to the point that those that would deny us our idols are met with fierce resistance and swift destruction, by word and/or deed.

In the world: Life is about getting what we want. (Idols) In Christ: The only options are to be merciful and gracious.

Key Point of This Habakkuk Narrative:

Pride leads to idols and idols lead to a destructive self-determination and God will judge both.

The Antidote? Humility
