# Who does Jesus think He is?

To the Jews who had believed him, Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples.

John 8:31

## Jesus makes two astounding claims to his audience.

## Claim 1-I can give you a free relationship with the Father.

(One based on intimacy and security, whereas your supposed relationship is based on performance, compulsion and fear.)

"...you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." John 8:32

"Now a slave has no permanent place in the family, but a son belongs to it forever."

John 8:35

## Claim 2-I alone can give you an eternal life.

"I tell you the truth, if anyone keeps my word, he will never see death."

John 8:51

You can see why they start to ask, "Who do you think you are?" Jesus gives them a twofold answer that is over the top.

#### 1. I was alive when Abraham was alive.

Your father Abraham rejoiced at the thought of seeing my day; he saw it and was glad."

John 8:56

And they heard it as such, because they respond,

... <sup>57</sup> "You are not yet fifty years old," the Jews said to him, "and you have seen Abraham!"

John 8:57

## 2. I am God and maker of Abraham

"I tell you the truth," Jesus answered, "before Abraham was, I am!" John 8:58

His audience knew immediately what he was claiming:

At this, they picked up stones to stone him, but Jesus hid himself, slipping away from the temple grounds.

John 8:59

# There has never been a more profound revelation of who God is than the name *I am*.

God said to Moses, "I am who I am. This is what you are to say to the Israelites 'I am has sent me to you.'" Exodus 3:14

"I AM THAT I AM," the self determining name. The name of the creator God. "I am... uncaused. I am.. self-existent."

God is saying, "I am, simply because I am."

Up until the moment of Exodus 3, the Hebrew name Elohim, the generic word for God was used.

Hebrew scribes who copied scriptures for centuries purposefully left off the vowels of God's name so all that they would record were the consonants.

## **YWHW**

(Known as the Tetragrammaton)

The consensus among scholars is that the historical vocalization of the Tetragrammaton is most likely **Yahweh.** Though for years people thought the name of God was **Jehovah**.

The mix up in the transliteration was due to the scribes, again purposefully, attaching the wrong vowels; the vowels for *Adonai* (Lord or Master), to the side notes of YHWH on their copies. The *Adonai* vowels added to the tetragrammaton YWHW would spell Jehovah. They did this so no one would actually use the real name of God, YAHWEH, in their worship time.

# **Apostle Paul wrote of Jesus:**

He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. <sup>16</sup> For by Him all things were created, *both* in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things have been created through Him and for Him. <sup>17</sup> He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together.

Colossians 1:15-17
