

God the Giver of Truth **John 16:12-15**

I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear. ¹³ But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come. ¹⁴ He will bring glory to me by taking from what is mine and making it known to you. ¹⁵ All that belongs to the Father is mine. That is why I said the Spirit will take from what is mine and make it known to you.

1. God is the giver of truth.

But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come.
John 16:13

When Jesus says,

"But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth"

John 16:13

Jesus doesn't mean all the truth in the world. Because there's nothing in the Bible about microbiology, aerodynamics, nuclear fusion and on and on.

What it does he mean is He will give you all the truth you need?

What Jesus says is "I'm going to give to you all the truth you need because it's all the truth about me."

2. God gives us truth about His Son.

He will bring glory to me by taking from what is mine and making it known to you.

John 16:14

What belongs to Jesus' that the Holy Spirit has given to us?

Christ is the visible image of the invisible God ...through him God created everything in the heavenly realms and on earth.

Colossians 1:15,16

This someone who is beyond human comprehension; and yet-

For God knew his people in advance, and he chose them to become like his Son

Romans 8:29

Certainly not in Jesus ruling power but like Him in character, sinless and glorified.

So now Jesus and the ones he makes holy have the same Father. That is why Jesus is not ashamed to call them his brothers and sisters.

Hebrews 2:11

And all that remains for us -

But we are citizens of heaven, where the Lord Jesus Christ lives. And we are eagerly waiting for him to return as our Savior. ²¹ He will take our weak mortal bodies and change them into glorious bodies like his own, using the same power with which he will bring everything under his control.
