

After the holidays passed Peter ran some blood work on her and from that point on everything changed. Peter took her to Renown Hospital and she was diagnosed with Acute Myeloid Leukemia 2 days later. She stayed in the hospital for an additional 10 weeks getting chemotherapy and countless blood transfusions. She was able to spend the summer at home and eventually was admitted to Stanford Hospital in the Fall of 2020 where she received a stem cell transplant. She lived in the SF Bay Area for about 3.5 months. Shortly after returning home she contracted a virus that had to be treated aggressively and was treated on and off for the entire year. In December 2021 she started having diffuse muscle atrophy that prompted her to be hospitalized at Stanford the next month. That was the last time she was home in South Lake Tahoe. Her hospital course at Stanford was very complex but she always fought so hard. Never losing hope that she would recover or questioning why this was happening to her. She died on April 10th with myself, her parents, and her brother with girlfriend at her side. She is survived by Peter, Shannon, Lukas, and the rest of her immediate family in Germany.

Sara and Peter eventually got married in her hometown in Germany on December 30, 2011, and she immigrated to the US a few months later. During those years they enjoyed the great Lake Tahoe lifestyle and she worked odd jobs. In 2013 they moved across the country to NYC where Peter started PA School. Sara worked as a nanny during that time. In 2014 while Peter was finishing up his studies in NY Sara started a graduate program in Mathematics at the University of Rhode Island. She had always been gifted at math and decided that she would like to teach it some day. As a graduate student she excelled in her studies and also taught undergraduate courses there as an instructor. She graduated in May 2016 with her Master's degree. Later that year their first child, Shannon, was born and we decided her being a stay at home mom was the best choice, especially when the kids were so young. They lived in Rhode Island for 4 years and during the time they had 2 kids, traveled frequently, and renovated a house. She excelled as both a mother and wife. Life was good. In December 2019 they moved back to South Lake Tahoe where Peter accepted a position at Renown Health in Carson City, NV. During the move Sara contracted a pretty intense head cold that eventually resolved after about a week but she never felt same afterwards. —————>
