Keeping Step with the Spirit

Paul describes living by the spirit as a choice.... Living "by the spirit" means that we submit to his authority, welcome his



guidance, except his correction, live under his restraint, rely on his power, and allow him to unify us with other believers. - Life Application Commentary: Galatians pg.179

Life in the flesh (Galatians 5:19-21)

Sexual sins: immorality, impurity, debauchery; idolatry & witchcraft

Relational Sins: hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions and envy;

Indulgent Sins: drunkenness, orgies, and the like.

Life in the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23)

the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness and self-control.

N.T. Wright says of the Spirit driven life, "A community that behaves like this, both internally and with outsiders will be inherently attractive!" -Galatians, pg.338

"the spirit is meant to have the same power over us as a pilot has over his ship or a charioteer over his horse." -J.Chrysostom Homily - Rom.14

Paul speaks of these qualities as "fruits"... there is a tendency in our modern world to suppose that they happen "naturally", in other words, that people should just want to be like that and shouldn't have to try too hard.... however a fruit tree needs to be planted and watered, tended and pruned, protected against the elements and various kinds of disease, and defended against attack from predators both animal and organic. *These qualities are, things you have to think through, work at, cultivate and practice.* -N.T. Wright, Galatians pg.337-338
