#### I. The Cross is Offensive

Those who are trying to force you to (obey the law in order to be saved) want to look good to others. They don't want to be persecuted for teaching that the cross of Christ alone can save.

#### What is the offense of the cross?



Jesus' death on the cross, teaches your sins are so bad that Jesus had to die for them.

#### Who do you say I am?

You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God.

Jesus taught them that the religious leaders would make him suffer many things. He told them he must be killed and then be raised from the dead on the third day. And Peter took Jesus aside and began to rebuke Him, saying, "God forbid it, Lord! This shall never happen to Matthew 16:21,22 You."

### But Jesus turned and said to Peter, "Get behind Me, Satan! You are a stumbling block to Me."



### II. Boasting in the Cross

But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners.

Romans 5:8



He persuaded a local farmer to hire him, and the man sent him into his fields to feed the pigs. 16 The young man became so hungry that even the pods he was feeding the pigs looked good to him. But no one gave him anything.

"When he finally came to his senses, he said to himself, 'At home even the hired servants have food enough to spare, and here I am dying of hunger! 18 I will go home to my father and say, "Father, I have sinned against both heaven and you, <sup>19</sup> and I am no longer worthy of being called your son. Please take me on as a hired servant."'

"So he returned home to his father. And while he was still a long way off, his father saw him coming. Filled with love and compassion, he ran to his son, embraced him, and kissed him. <sup>21</sup> His son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against both heaven and you, and I am no longer worthy of being called your son".

"The older brother was angry and wouldn't go in. His father came out and begged him, (to join the party) <sup>29</sup> but he replied, 'All these years I've slaved for you and never once refused to do a single thing you told me to.

And in all that time you never gave me even one young goat for a feast with my friends. <sup>30</sup> Yet when this son of yours comes back after squandering your money on prostitutes, you celebrate by killing the fattened calf!'

# III. How do I know Jesus died for my sins?

I passed on to you what was most important and what had also been passed on to me. Christ died for our sins, just as the Scriptures said. <sup>4</sup> He was buried, and he was raised from the dead on the third day, just as the Scriptures said.

He was seen by Peter and then by the Twelve. After that, he was seen by more than 500 of his followers at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have died.


The resurrection is actually God's way of giving us a receipt, stamping it "Paid in Full" across all of history.


"For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead comes also through a man. For as in Adam all die, so in Christ all will be made alive."


