


Sharing God's Story

When it comes to sharing God's story with others, there is no silver bullet. In these two chapters Paul and Barnabas have two very different methods of sharing the Good News about God. Likewise for us, it is helpful when we know our audience and learn to use language that they can relate to.



Sharing God's Story

Remember you're watching experts at work! What's the result? Some amazing stories but also some life threatening opposition! Don't be surprised when you experience opposition. Not everyone is going to be thrilled to hear the Good News about Jesus. To be fair, the real failure that day was mine. My decision to remain ashore was driven entirely by self-interest and fear. Not the fear of physical harm—I knew the instructor would rescue us if we got into real trouble, but the fear of humiliation.



There is no question that my presence on the boat would not have changed the outcome, but it would have been an expression of *loyalty and commitment to my family*. Rather than saying, "No matter what, we're all in this together!" I said, "Good luck, you guys are on your own."





Acts 5:41 The apostles left the Sanhedrin, rejoicing because they had been counted worthy of suffering disgrace for the Name.


