


### II. The Heaven Experience




After Dr. Jones passed a biographer wrote about his life. He shared a story that Dr. Jones had never shared publicly.








But the experience subsided, and his depression returned, then a short time later, the same thing happened to him again for several days.






Each time (God) said, "My grace is all you need. My power works best in weakness." I can do all things through Him who strengthens me. Philippians 4:13
