

4 Spring Festivals

Begins with Passover, the next day is the Feast of Unleavened Bread, the day following is the Feast of First Fruits.

Passover-Jesus is crucified; Unleavened Bread Jesus is in the grave. First Fruits Jesus is risen!

4 Spring Festivals

7 full weeks or 50 days after the start of First Fruits, the Festival of Weeks starts.

Since it takes place exactly 50 days after the previous feast, this feast is also known as "Pentecost" (Acts 2:1), which means "fifty" in Greek.

ACTS 21:1-3

After we had torn ourselves away from them, we put out to sea and sailed straight to Cos. The next day we went to Rhodes and from there to Patara. ² We found a ship crossing over to Phoenicia, went on board and set sail. ³ After sighting Cyprus and passing to the south of it, we sailed on to Syria. We landed at Tyre, where our ship was to unload its cargo.

⁴ Finding the disciples there, we stayed with them seven days. Through the Spirit they urged Paul not to go on to Jerusalem. ⁵ But when our time was up, we left and continued on our way. All the disciples and their wives and children accompanied us out of the city, and there on the beach we knelt to pray.

⁶After saying good-by to each other, we went aboard the ship, and they returned home. ⁷ We continued our voyage from Tyre and landed at Ptolemais, where we greeted the brothers and stayed with them for a day. ⁸Leaving the next day, we reached Caesarea and stayed at the house of Philip the evangelist, one of the Seven.

ACTS 21:3,4

Through the Spirit they urged Paul not to go on to Jerusalem.



For since our friendship with God was restored by the death of his Son while we were still his enemies, we will certainly be saved through the life of his Son.


