For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—<sup>9</sup> not by works, so that no one can boast.


<sup>10</sup> For we are God's handiwork, *created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.* Ephesians 2:10

I was caught up to paradise and heard things so astounding that they cannot be expressed in words, things no human is allowed to tell. <sup>5</sup> That experience is worth boasting about, but I'm not going to do it.
